## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\oplus}$ : 1 skein each of 722 Pretty 'N Pink A and 356 Amethyst B for Hat; 1 skein each of 722 Pretty ' $N$ Pink A, 356 Amethyst B and 254 Pumpkin C for Shawl
Note: If making both, one skein each will complete designs

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hooks: 5 mm [US H-8] for Hat. 6mm [US J -10] for Shawl

Yarn needle, removable st marker
GAUGE: With smaller hook in Hat pattern, 8 sc and 8 rounds $\mathrm{sc}=2$ " $(5 \mathrm{~cm})$. With larger hook in Shawl pattern, 10 sc and 4 rows in $\mathrm{tr}=$ $4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

## Little Witch Hat \& Shawl

Crochet a hat and shawl for your charming mini witch! Customize the look by using her favorite colors, which we're betting are pink and purple.

Hat measures 13" (33 cm) tall and 20" ( 51 cm ) in circumference

## HAT

Round 1 (right side): Starting at top of hat, With smaller hook and $\mathbf{A}$, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, do not join, place marker at beginning of round, work in a spiral, moving marker up as work progresses.
Round 2: Sc in each sc around.
Round 3: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc; repeat from * once - 8 sc.
Round 4: Sc in each sc around.
Round 5: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc; repeat from * once - 10 sc.
Round 6: Sc in each of next 10 sc.
Round 7: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4 sc; repeat from * once - 12 sc.
Round 8: Sc in each of next 12 sc
Round 9: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc; repeat from * once - 14 sc.
Round 10: Sc in each of next 14 sc .
Round 11: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc; repeat from * once - 16 sc.
Round 12: Sc in each of next 16 sc .
Round 13: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc; repeat from * once - 18 sc.
Round 14: Sc in each of next 18 sc .
Round 15: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc; repeat from * twice - 21 sc.
Round 16: Sc in each of next 21 sc .
Round 17: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc; repeat from * twice - 24 sc.
Round 18: Sc in each of next 24 sc .
Round 19: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc; repeat from * twice - 27 sc.
Round 20: Sc in each of next 27 sc .
Round 21: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc; repeat from * twice - 30 sc.
Round 22: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 9 sc; repeat from * twice - 33 sc.
Round 23: Sc in each of next 33 sc .

Round 24: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 10 sc; repeat from * twice -36 sc.
Round 25: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 11 sc; repeat from * twice - 39 sc.
Round 26: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 12 sc; repeat from * twice - 42 sc.
Round 27: Sc in each of next 42 sc .
Round 28: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 13 sc ; repeat from * twice - 45 sc.
Round 29: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 14 sc; repeat from * twice - 48 sc.
Round 30: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 15 sc; repeat from * twice - 51 sc.
Round 31: Sc in each of next 51 sc ,
Round 32: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 16 sc; repeat from * twice - 54 sc.
Round 33: Sc in each of next 54 sc .
Round 34: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 17 sc ; repeat from * twice -57 sc .
Round 35: Sc in each of next 57 sc .
Round 36: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 18 sc; repeat from * twice - 60 sc.
Round 37: Sc in each of next 60 sc .
Round 38: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 19 sc; repeat from * twice - 63 sc.
Round 39: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 20 sc; repeat from * twice - 66 sc.
Round 40: Sc in each of next 66 sc .
Round 41: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 21 sc; repeat from * twice - 69 sc.
Round 42: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 22 sc; repeat from * twice - 72 sc.
Round 43: Sc in each of next 72 sc.
Round 44: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 23 sc; repeat from * twice - 75 sc.
Round 45: *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 24 sc; repeat from * twice - 78 sc.
Round 46: Sc in first 26 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 25 sc; repeat from * once - 80 sc.

Round 47-48: Sc in each of next 80 sc. Fasten off $A$.

## Yarnspirations

Round 49: With right side facing, join B with a slip st in first sc, ch 1, sc in first st and in each s around; join with a slip st in first sc.
Round 50-55: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off B
Round 56: With right side facing, join A with a slip st in first sc, ch 1, sc in first st and in each sc around; join with a slip st in first sc. Do not fasten off.

## Brim

Round 57: Ch 1, working in front loops only, *2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 7 sc ; repeat from * around; join with a slip st in first SC 90 sc.
Round 58: Ch 1, working in both loops of sts, *2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 8 sc ; repeat from * around; join with a slip st in first sc 100 sc
Round 59: Ch 1, *2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 9 sc ; repeat from * around; join with a slip st in first sc - 110 sc.
Round 60: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with a slip st in first sc.
Round 61: Ch 1, *2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 10 sc; repeat from * around; join with a slip st in first sc - 120 sc.
Round 62: Ch 1, *2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 11 sc; repeat from * around; join with a slip st in first sc - 130 sc.
Round 63: Ch 1,*2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 12 sc ; repeat from * around; join with a slip st in first SC - 140 SC. Fasten off A. Round 64: With right side facing, join $\mathbf{B}$ with a slip st in first Sc, ch 1, sc in each Sc around; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off B. Weave in ends.

Shawl directions are for size 4. Changes for size 8 are in parentheses.

Shawl measures 18 (22)" ( 45.5 [56] cm) long.

## SHAWL

NOTE: Colors are changed at the end of each row, before pulling through the last 2 loops of the last tr, drop old color and draw through new color and then ch 4 with new color.

## Color Sequence

Work in the following color sequence: 1 row each of *C, B, A, B; repeat from * throughout.

With larger hook and $\mathbf{C}$, ch 3 ; join with a slip st to first ch to form ring.
Row 1: Ch 4, (2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) in ring, change to B while completing last tr, turn.
Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as tr here and throughout, 2 tr in space between first 2 tr, *tr in next space between sts, rep from * across to next ch-2 space, (2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr) in next ch-2 space; repeat from * across to last space, 3 tr in space between last 2 tr , change to $\mathbf{A}$ while completing last st, turn.
Row 3: Repeat Row 2, changing to $\mathbf{B}$ while completing last tr, turn.
Rows 4-18 (22): Maintaining color sequence as established, repeat Row 2 (15 [19] times), change to $\mathbf{B}$ at end of last row.

## Edging

With B, ch 2, hdc evenly around entire Shawl working 3 hdc in each corner and in ch-2 space in center; join with a slip st in first hdc. Fasten off B. Weave in ends.

A, B, C = color A, B, C; ch = chain; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
