



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

K = Knit

K1below = Knit into next stitch 1 row below at the same time slipping off stitch above

P = Purl

P1below = Purl into next stitch 1 row below at the same time slipping off stitch above

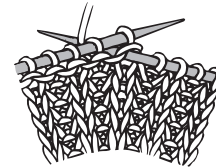
Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side



MEASUREMENTS

Approx 6 x 72" [15 x 183 cm]

GAUGE

14 sts and 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Work 2 rows on RS then 2 rows on WS.

With pair of double-pointed needles and B, cast on 21 sts.

1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: (RS). With A, K1. *P1below. K1. Rep from * to end of row. **Do not** turn. Slide sts to opposite end of needle.

3rd row: (RS). With B, K1. *P1. K1below. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P1. K1. Turn.

4th row: (WS). With A, K1. *K1below. P1. Rep from * to end of row. **Do not** turn. Slide sts to opposite end of needle.

5th row: (WS). With B, K1. *K1. P1below. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2. Turn.

Rep 2nd to 5th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 72" [183 cm], ending on 3rd row. With B, cast off loosely.

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Soft Essentials™ (5 oz/141 g; 131 yds/120 m)

Contrast A Greyhound (7405) **1 ball**

Contrast B Navy (7851) **1 ball**

Pair of size U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
