ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZE

One size to fit adult.

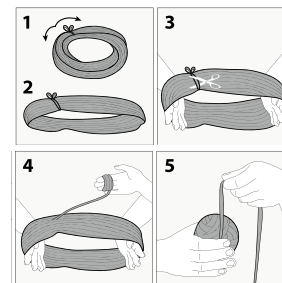
GAUGE

12 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Colorwork Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone™ color # (see label).
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results
- When working from chart and joining new color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Carry color when not in use loosely across top of previous rnd and work sts around it to avoid stranding.

With E ch 8.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 7 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 19" [48.5 cm] when slightly stretched. **Do not** fasten off.

Join last row and first row tog with 1 row of sc to form tube. Break E.

Beg working in rnds:

Foundation rnd: (RS). Join B with sl st at seam. Ch 1. *Working along side edge of ribbing*, work 56 sc evenly around. Join with sl st to first sc. Place marker at end of rnd.

1st to 18th rnds: Ch 1. Work Chart to end of chart, noting 4-st rep will be worked 14 times. Join with sl st to first sc at end of each rnd.

When Chart is complete break D and cont with C.

****Shape top: 1st rnd:** Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 49 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 42 sc.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 35 sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 28 sc.

5th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 21 sc.

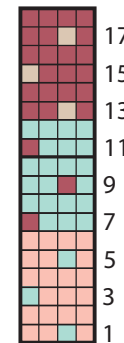
6th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 14 sc.

7th rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 7 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and secure tightly.**

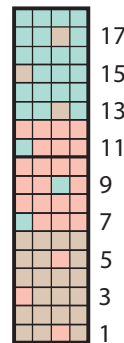
Version 1 Chart



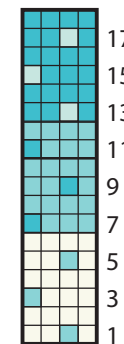
