## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Soft®:** 2 balls  
9274 Biscuit **A**, 1 ball 4601 Off  
White **B**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5mm [US H-8] and 6.5mm  
[US K-10½]

Stitch marker, yarn needle, 18"  
[46 cm] x 18" [46 cm] pillow  
form

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical  
for this project.



**RED HEART® Soft®**,  
Art. E728 available  
in solid color 5 oz  
(141 g), 256 yd (234 m), print  
4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m),  
and heather 4 oz (113 g), 212  
yd (194 m) balls

# Crochet Starfish Pillow

This wonderfully designed starfish is  
sewn onto the crocheted pillow cover  
for cool beachy style. It's the ideal  
accent for a sofa or comfy chair.

SHOP KIT

**Pillow measures 18" [46 cm] x 18" [46 cm].**

## NOTES

Pillow cover is constructed in 2 parts  
and is seamed together using a slip  
stitch. Additional single crochet rounds  
are completed after seaming to add  
accent edging. These rounds are  
designed to curl upwards in order to  
simulate piping.

Keep pillow form handy for fitting, as  
cover pieces are worked, to insure a  
tight, proper fit. Adjust row and stitch  
numbers up or down as needed. A  
somewhat open fabric is achieved when  
cover is worked as directed, allowing  
the pillow form fabric to show through,  
(use a pillow insert in a coordinating  
color for custom layered look). If a more  
solid, dense fabric is desired, use smaller  
hook with increased number of rows  
and stitches.

Starfish motif is worked with yarn held  
doubled using larger hook. Each of  
the 5 arms of the starfish are worked  
separately and seamed together after  
all are completed. For ease in seaming,  
weave and trim all ends as arms are  
completed.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Picot stitch:** Slip stitch in next stitch,  
chain 3, slip stitch in same space.

## PILLOW COVER (make 2)

With **A** and smaller hook, ch 54 loosely.

**Row 1:** Working in back bumps of  
foundation ch, hdc in 3rd ch from hook,  
hdc in each ch across - 52 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, hdc in each st across.

**Rows 4-49:** Repeat Rows 2-3.

Fasten off after Row 49 and set aside.  
Repeat for 2nd piece but do not fasten  
off.

**Joining Round 50:** Holding two pieces  
with wrong sides together and sts  
aligned, working through both layers  
along side edges, slip st 62 sts evenly  
spaced across, turn and working  
through both layers of foundation ch,  
slip st in each ch across, turn to work  
along opposite side edge, work 62 slip  
sts evenly spaced along row edges,  
insert pillow form and slip st in each st  
across last edge to close, slip st in first  
st.

**Rounds 51-52:** Ch 1, sc in each slip st  
around, working 3 sc in each corner st,  
slip st in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in  
ends.

## STARFISH ARMS (make 5)

With larger hook and holding 2 strands  
of **B** together, ch 14.

**Round 1:** Sc in first ch, place marker, sc  
in next 11 ch, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last  
ch, turn to work along opposite edge of  
foundation ch, sc in next 12 ch, slip st in  
first sc - 28 sts.

**Round 2:** Working in back loops only,  
ch 1, sc in same space, slip marker, sc in  
next st, hdc in next 4 sts, dc in next 5 sts,  
4 dc in next st, ch 1, skip next 2 dc from  
previous round, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next  
ch-2 space, skip next 2 dc, ch 1, 4 dc in  
next st, dc in next 5 sts, hdc in next 4  
sts, sc in last 2 sts, slip st in first sc. Mark  
ch-2 space with yarn scrap for seaming.  
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

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## FINISHING

Hold 2 arms with wrong sides together at the marked ch-2 spaces.

Working through both layers, join doubled yarn with slip stitch to ch-2 spaces, ch 1, sc in same space, working in the back loops of top arm sts and front loops of bottom arm sts, sc in next 7 dc.

Fasten off. Weave in ends. Repeat to join remaining arms. Do not fasten off after joining last 2 arms,

## Edging

Slip st in next 2 sts from the arm sts, \*ch 3, slip st in same space, slip st in next 2 sts; repeat from \* around, slip st in first st. Fasten off.

There should be a picot in every other st around entire motif. Do not picot in row ends created from arm joins.

## Center

With right side facing, join 2 strands of **B** in any ch-2 space in center of motif, ch 1, 2 sc in same space, 2 sc in each ch-2 space around, slip st in first sc to join. Weave in ends.

Pin starfish to center of pillow. Smooth arms out towards edges and pin in place.

Using 1 strand of **B** and yarn needle, join motif with small whipstitches. Do not pull yarn too tightly in order to avoid puckers. Knot yarn securely. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color **A, B, C**; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* **or \*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
