 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52" x 60" [132 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

7 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With MC: 40 rows.

With A: 26 rows.

With MC: 16 rows.

With B: 26 rows.

With MC: 16 rows.

With A: 26 rows.

With MC: 90 rows.

These 240 rows form Stripe Pattern (pat).

With MC, cast on 91 stitches (sts). **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit in rows (garter st), noting 1st row is wrong side (WS), until 240 rows of Stripe Pat have been completed.

Cast off.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Main Color (MC) Pale Grey (10046) **3 balls or 515 yds/471 m**

Contrast A Dark Grey (10044) **1 ball or 187 yds/171 m**

Bernat® Blanket™ (5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m)

Contrast B Vintage White (00006) **1 ball or 85 yds/77 m**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
