## **MATERIALS**

**Caron**<sup>®</sup> **x Pantone**<sup>™</sup> (3.5 oz /100 g; 127 yds/116 m) Fuchsia Folliage (01020) 1 braid for all sizes

Set of 4 sizes U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) and U.S. 10 (6 mm) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Alt** = Alternate(ing)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches

together

**Kfb** = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

**PM** = Place marker

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

# **SIZES**

**To fit 2/4 yrs (8/10 yrs - Adult)** 

# **GAUGE**


15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking stitch.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes necessary for larger sizes the • instructions will be written thus ( ). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers • pertaining to your size.

### **Notes:**

Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will referenced by its Pantone #
- Designate each yarn ball Contrast, A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results

### RIGHT MITTEN

\*\*With set of smaller doublepointed needles and A, cast on **20** (26-30) sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles **7**, **7**, **6** (**9**, **9**, **8**-10, 10, 10). Join in rnd, PM on first st.

1st rnd: \*K1.P1.Rep from \* around. Rep last rnd of (K1. P1) ribbing for 1½ (2½-2½)" [4 (5.5-5.5) cm]. Break A.

With C and larger needles, knit 2 (4-6) rnds.\*\*

K10 (13-15). (Kfb) twice. Knit to end of rnd. 22 (28-32) sts.

and alt rnds: 2nd **3rd rnd:** K10 (13-15). Kfb. K2. Kfb. 3 sts. K2tog. K1. Knit to end of rnd. 24 (30-34) sts.

5th rnd: K(13-15). Kfb. K4. Kfb. Knit Thread end through rem 8 (10to end of rnd. (32-36) sts.

6th rnd: Knit.

Size Adult only: 7th rnd: K15. Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 38 sts. 8th rnd: Knit.

All sizes: Next rnd: K16 (21-**25**). Slip last **6** (8-10) sts onto safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd. Break C.

Next rnd: With D, knit, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. **20** (26-30) sts.

\*\*\*With D, knit 3 rnds. Break D. With E, knit in rnds until work after ribbing measures 31/2 (5-6)" [9 (12.5-15) cml.

Rearrange sts as follows: 10 (13-15) sts on 1st needle. 5 (6-7) sts on 2nd needle and 5 (7-8) sts on 3rd needle.

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: Shape top: 1st rnd: 1st needle: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle: K1. ssk. Knit to end Knit. of needle. 3rd needle: Knit to last

2nd rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds until 8 (10-10) sts Sizes 8/10 and Adult only: rem. Break E, leaving a long end. 10) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

> Thumb: With B, K6 (8-10) from safety pin. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of thumb. Divide these 8 (10-12) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit 6 (8-10) rnds even.

**Next rnd:** (K2toq) **4** (**5**-**6**) times. Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 4 (5-6) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.\*\*\*

### **LEFT MITTEN**

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Right Mitten, substituting B for A, D for C.

Proceed as follows:

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K8 (11-13). (Kfb) twice. Knit to end of rnd.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit. 3rd rnd: K8 (11-13). Kfb. K2. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 24 (30-34) sts.

Sizes 8/10 and Adult only: **5th rnd:** K(11-13), Kfb, K4, Kfb, Knit to end of rnd. (32-36) sts. 6th rnd: Knit.

Size Adult only: 7th rnd: K13. Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 38 sts. 8th rnd: Knit.

All sizes: Next rnd: K14 (19-23). Slip last 6 (8-10) sts onto safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd. Break D.

**Next rnd:** With B, knit, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. 20 (26-**30**) sts.

Work from \*\*\* to \*\*\* as given for Right Mitten, substituting B for D, A for E and C for B.
