What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:

1 skein each 400 Grey Heather,
334 Buff, and 319 Cherry Red

Susan Bates® Easy Wrap Pom
Pon Maker, 12" (30.5 cm) length
of 1/4" (5 cm) diameter dowel,
scissors, sheet of paper

SHOP KIT

Pompom Wall Hanging

If you're looking for a project that displays your love of yarn without using needles or hooks, this wall hanging is perfect. Collect your favorite yarn colors and have a crafty pompom party with your friends or kids and create this modern hip addition to your décor!

Wall hanging measures 12" (30.5 cm)
wide x 15" (38 cm) long, excluding hanger.

Note

1. Model was made with 2 1/4" (5.5 cm) Pom Pon Maker.
2. Alternate colors when making pompoms.

WALL HANGING

Pompom (make 24)

Step 1: With any two colors, wrap one half of Pompom Maker. Wrap 3rd color around other half of Pompom maker. This wrapping technique will create a tri-colored pompom.



Step 2: Interlock halves together.



Step 3: Cut along Pompom Maker seam.
Trim around seam evenly.



Step 4: Place sheet of paper under pompom for easier clean-up and trim edges evenly to desired shape.

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Step 5: With a strand of any color, tie tightly around center. Do not trim this tie.



Step 6: Remove Pompom Maker pieces and fluff pom-pom to fullness.



Hanger and Hanging Strands

Step 1: Cut 5 strands of Cherry Red each measuring 60" (151 cm) long. Hold 2 strands together, fold in half and tie them together at the fold. Measure 10" (25.5 cm) from center knot and tie the strands together; repeat on other side of knot. Place dowel under each knot and tie strands together under the dowel to hold the dowel in place.



Step 2: Fold each remaining strand in half and tie around center of dowel between strands of hanger. Arrange pom-poms into 5 columns (model shows, in each column from left to right, 4, 5, 6, 5, and 4 pom-poms).



Step 3: Beginning with hanging strand at right, tie a knot 1" (2.5 cm) below last knot made.



Step 4: With tails from center tie, tie a pom-pom on this knot. Trim ends of tie.



Step 5: On the same strand, tie a knot 2" (5 cm) below the previous knot made.



Repeat from Step 4 until all pom-poms are attached to current strand. Continuing with next hanging strand, repeat last 3 steps until all pom-poms are attached on each strand as shown in photograph or as desired.



Trim ends of hanging strands close to last knot made.
