## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Hygge™:** 6 balls  
8340 Sterling

**Susan Bates® Circular Needle:**  
10mm [US 15], 24" long or  
longer

Cable needle, yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 12 sts = 4" [10 cm];  
14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in  
Stockinette stitch (knit on  
right side, purl on wrong  
side). 12 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 18  
rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter  
stitch (knit each stitch in  
every row). Each cable  
measures about 3" [7.5 cm]  
wide. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
Use any size needle to obtain  
the gauge. Exact gauge is not  
critical to this project.

# Braided Cable Knit Throw

Fall in love with this most wonderful, soft  
yarn with a short furry texture. Not only will  
you love knitting with this bulky weight yarn,  
you will enjoy wrapping yourself in luxurious  
softness for years to come.

Throw measures 35" [89 cm] wide x  
48" [122 cm] long. It is very stretchy in  
both directions.

## Notes

1. Circular needle is used to  
accommodate large number of  
stitches. Work back and forth on  
circular needle as if working with  
straight needles.
2. Cable pattern can be worked from  
written instructions or by following  
chart. Read right side rows of chart  
from right to left and wrong side  
rows from left to right.

## Special Stitches

**3/3 LC** (3 over 3 left cross) = Slip next 3  
sts to cable needle and hold in front, k3,  
then k3 from cable needle.

**3/3 RC** (3 over 3 right cross) = Slip next  
3 sts to cable needle and hold in back,  
k3, then k3 from cable needle.

## THROW

Cast on 105 sts.

### Lower Border

**Row 1 (right side):** K1, \*p1, k1; repeat  
from \* across.

**Row 2:** P1, \*k1, p1; repeat from \* across.

**Rows 3-8:** Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for 3  
more times.

**Row 9:** Repeat Row 1.

### Begin Cable Pattern

**Set-Up Row (wrong side):** K10, \*p9, k10;  
repeat from \* across.

**Row 1 (right side):** Knit.

**Row 2:** K10, \*p9, k10; repeat from \*  
across.

**Row 3:** K10, \*3/3 LC, k13; repeat from \*  
across.

**Row 4:** Repeat Row 2.

**Rows 5-8:** Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice.

**Row 9:** \*K13, 3/3 RC; repeat from \* to  
last 10 sts, k10.



**Row 10:** Repeat Row 2.

**Rows 11-14:** Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice.

**Rows 15-170:** Repeat Rows 3-14 for 13  
more times.

**Rows 171-175:** Repeat Rows 3-7.

### Top Border

**Row 1 (wrong side):** P1, \*k1, p1; repeat  
from \* across.

**Row 2:** K1, \*p1, k1; repeat from \* across.

**Rows 3-8:** Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for 3  
more times.

**Row 9:** Repeat Row 1.

Bind off loosely in pattern.

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## FINISHING

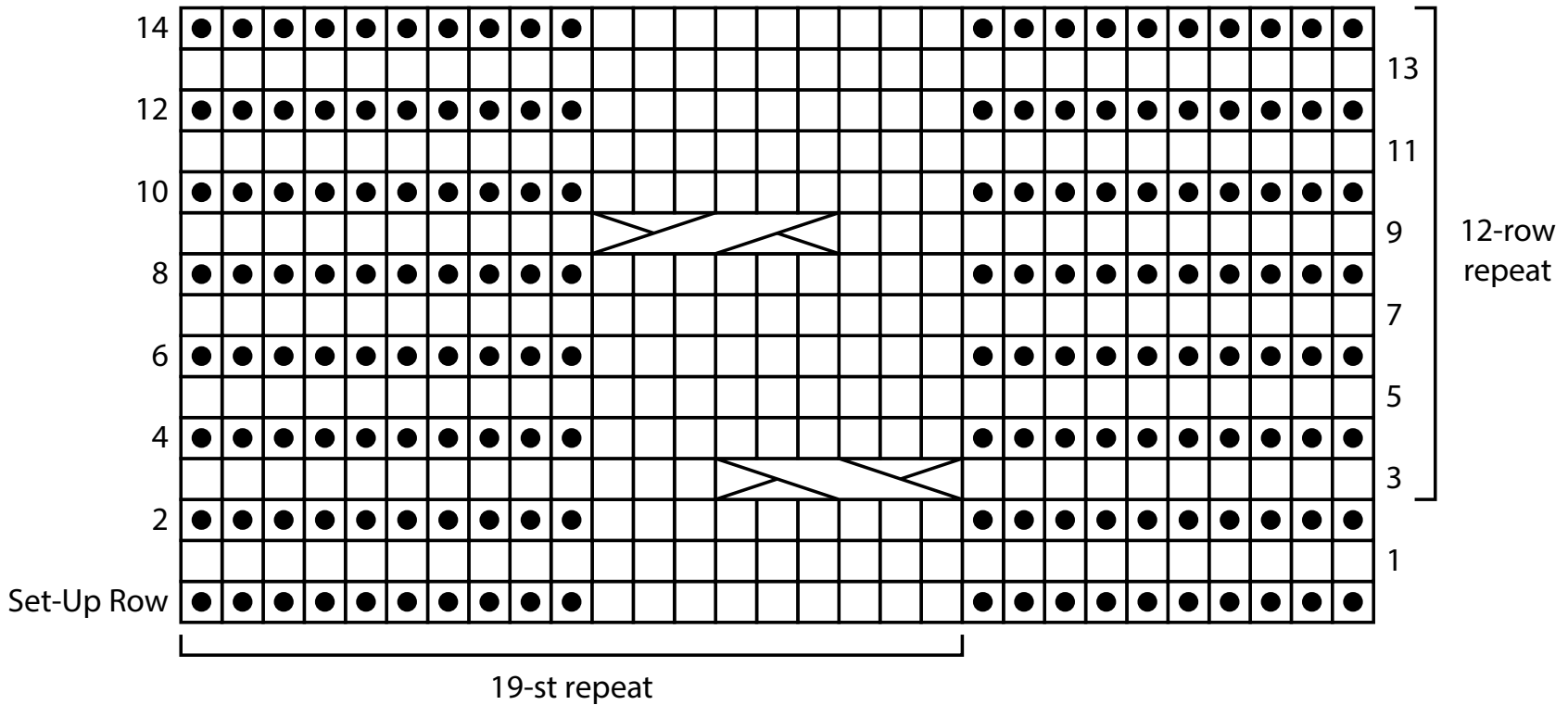
Weave in ends.

**k** = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es);  
\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as  
indicated.
