What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™: 2 balls 1930 Horizon

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6.5mm [US 10.5]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" (10 cm); 18 rows = 4" (10 cm) in 2x2 Rib, slightly stretched. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Warm Ribbed Boot Cuffs

Using shaded yarn and an easy rib knit pattern, it won't take long to knit the perfect boot cuffs. They'll stretch to neatly fit your boots and then keep out the cold in style!

Finished Circumference

13½ (15½, 17½)" (34.5 (39.5, 44.5 cm)

Finished Length

10" (25.5 cm)

Directions are for size Women's Small. Changes for sizes Women's Medium and Women's Large are in parentheses.

Special Techniques

Picot Bind off = *Cast on 2 sts using cable cast on method below, immediately bind off 4 sts, slip the first stitch on right hand needle back to left hand needle; repeat from * across.

Cable Cast On (used for Picot Bind Off) =

Hold work so stitches are on left needle,
*insert needle between first and 2nd stitch on
left needle, wrap and draw loop through (as if
making a knit st), slip the new stitch back onto
the left needle; repeat from * until the desired
number of stitches have been cast on.

Pattern Stitch

2x2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts + 2)

Row 1 (right side): K2, *p2, k2; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2: Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts to end of row.

Repeat Row 2 for 2x2 Rib.

CUFF (make 2)

Cast on 58 (66, 74) sts.

Row 1 (wrong side): Knit.

Work in 2x2 Rib until piece measures 10" (25.5 cm) from beginning, end with a right side row.

With wrong side facing, work picot bind off.

FINISHING

With right sides together, wrong side facing, sew side seam. Weave in ends. Insert into boot and fold over top.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
