



## MATERIALS

### Anchor Stitchable Felt™ Sheets:

1 each white and hot pink

### Anchor Stranded Cotton Embroidery Floss:

(2) Anchor #52 pink

(1) Anchor #1 White floss

Clear fabric glue

Large-eye tapestry needle

Scissors

### Featuring Anchor Stitchable Felt™

The seven-holes-to-an-inch perforated felt is great for creative cross-stitch projects. Make this Valentine Treat Box for your special Valentine!!

### CUTTING

1. Following the cutting diagram on page 2, cut out the treat box base from hot pink Stitchable Felt.
2. Cut out four white hearts following the cutting diagram.
3. Cut four squares 2¼" x 2¼" (5.71cm x 5.71cm) for lining pieces

### STITCHING

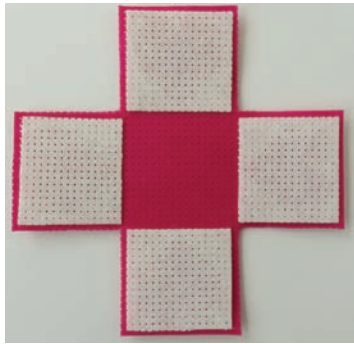
1. Thread with light pink embroidery floss.
2. On the white heart, stitch following the diagram, leaving the outer most line, solid line unstitched.
3. Repeat for the other three hearts.
4. Place the first heart on the hot

pink base.

5. Stitch around the outer line of the heart attaching it to the base.
6. Repeat with the other three hearts.
7. Thread with white floss.
8. Stitch the vertical lines following the stitching diagram.



9. Place the cut 2¼" x 2¼" (5.71cm x 5.71cm) white squares in place on the base and glue with clear fabric glue. This will give you a nice, neat, clean inside!



10. Fold the felt into a box shape.  
11. Stitch the corners together going into every other hole. Don't pull too tight. Leave the stitching loose enough that the edges stay square and don't pull in.



12. To secure the top corners, thread the floss tail into between the layers of felt and put a drop of clear fabric glue at the top as shown.



13. Fill your treat box with candy and give to your favorite Valentine!
