

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Softee $^{\oplus}$ Chunky $^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $14 \mathrm{oz} / 400 \mathrm{~g} ; 431 \mathrm{yds} / 394 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Sizes $\quad 2 / 4$ yrs $\quad 6 / 10$ yrs Adult

Natural (30008) or Gray Ragg (30047) or Gray Heather (30046) or Teal (30203) or True Gray (30044)
Note: 1 ball will make $4\binom{1}{(3-3)}$ Hats.
Size U.S. $10122(6.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

## SIZES

To fit head sizes
Child 2/4 years
19" [ 48 cm ] circumference
Child 6/10 years
20 " 51 cm ] circumference
Adult
21-22" [53.5-56 cm]
circumference

## GAUGE

12 sts and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus ( ).

Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Cast on 55 (59-63) sts.
1st row: *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K2. P1.
Rep last row for Mistake Rib Pat for $7(81 / 2-91 / 2)$ " [18 (21.5-24) cm].

Shape top: 1st row: (RS). *K1. P3tog. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K1. P2tog. 28 (30-32) sts.
2nd to 6th rows: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
7th row: (RS). K1. *K2tog. Rep from * to last st. P1. 15 (16-17) sts. Break yarn leaving a long end.

## BERNAP BASIC KNIT RIBBED FAMILY HAT \| KNIT

Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew center back seam. Turn back cuff as shown.

Pompom: Wind yarn around 3 (4-4) fingers approx 70 (8080) times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape, approx 3 (4-4)" $[7.5$ (10-10) cm] diameter. Sew to top of Hat.
