What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft Baby Steps®: 3 balls each of 9620 Baby Green (A) and 9505 Aqua (B)

KB Loom: Sock Loom 2

Notions: Knitting tool, tapestry needle

Gauge: 8.5sts x 12 rows = 2 inches (5cm) **CHECK YOUR GAUGE**

Hearts Blanket

Wrap your little one in a loving blanket knit on a loom instead of needles. Hearts are formed by following the chart for knit and purl stitches. This smooth yarn feels good on baby's skin, while being easy to machine wash and dry.

INSTRUCTIONS

PANEL 1

Make 3

With A, cast on 29 sts, prepare to work a flat panel. <http://www.knittingboard.com/ewrap-cast-on-page/>

Row 1: K to the end of row.

Row 2: P to the end of row.

***Work Rows 1-37:** of Heart Chart. Cut A and join B.

Work Rows 1-37: of Plain Block Chart. *

Repeat from * to *: 3 more times (total of 6 blocks).

Next row: P to the end of row.

Next row: K to the end of row.

Bind off with basic bind off method.

PANEL 2

Make 2

With B, cast on 29 sts, prepare to work a flat panel,

Row 1: K to the end of row.

Row 2: P to the end of row.

***Work Rows 1-37:** of Plain Block Chart. Cut B and join A.

Work Rows 1-37: of Heart Block Chart.*

Repeat from * to *: 3 more times (total of 6 blocks).

Next row: P to the end of row.

Next row: K to the end of row.

Bind off with basic bind off method.
