What you will need:

RED HEART® Baby Clouds™:
1 (1, 2, 2) skeins 9936 Sandcastle.

Susan Bates® Straight Knitting
Needles: 9mm [US 13]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 8½ sts = 4" (10 cm); 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Baby Clouds™, Art. E710
available in solid color 6 oz (170 g), 140 yd (128m) and multicolor and swirl 4.5 oz (127 g), 105 yd (96 m) skeins.



Tunic for Baby

Perfect for busy knitters, this quick to make tunic features a fashionable square neckline and pretty bow. It's ideal for the little miss to wear with leggings, jeans or other pants.

Directions are for size 6 months. Change for sizes 9, 12, and 18 months are in parentheses

Finished Chest: 18 (20, 22, 24)" [46 (51, 56, 61) cm]

Finished Length: 10 (11½, 13, 14½)" [25 (29, 33, 37) cm]

Note

Wind off a small ball of yarn separately to use for neck shaping for sizes made with only 1 ball.

TUNIC

Back and Front (make 2)

Cast on 23 (25, 27, 29) sts.

Rows 1-4: Knit.

Rows 5 and 7 (Wrong Side): K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 6, 10, 12, 14: Knit.

Rows 8 and 16: K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—19 (21, 23, 25) sts.

Rows 9, 11, 13, 15: Purl.

Work even in stockinette stitch until piece measures 5 (6, 7, 8)" [13 (15, 18, 20) cm]. Knit 2 rows.

Shape Armholes

Working in garter stitch, bind off 1 st at beginning of next 2 rows—17 (19, 21, 23) sts. Knit 6 (8, 10, 12) rows.

Shape Neck

K4 (5, 6, 7), join another ball of yarn and bind off center 9 sts, k4 (5, 6, 7). Working both sides separately at the same time, knit 9 rows. Bind off.

Finishing

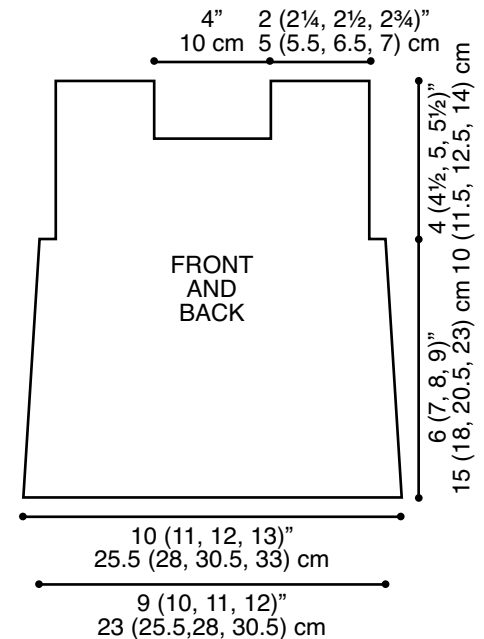
Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams from underarm to Row 8, leaving last rows open for vent.

Bow

Cast on 6 sts. Knit 20 rows. Bind off. Weave in ends. With another piece of yarn, gather center of strip and sew to front of tunic.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 stitches together; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
