## BRILLA BEANIE

KNITTING



### WHAT YOU NEED

**RED HEART® Luce™:** 1 ball 6724 Rosa

**Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:** 4mm [US 6]

Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 19 sts = about 4" [10 cm]; 24 rows = about 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

**BUY YARN**



**RED HEART® Luce™:** Art R180 available in 3.5 oz (100 g) 218 yds (199 m) balls



### Notes

1. Hat is also shown in 6311 Bianco and 6340 Granito at end of pattern
2. Hat is worked back and forth in rows from the lower edge upwards.
3. Side edges are sewn together to complete hat.
4. If desired, the hat can also be worked in the round on double pointed needles.

### HAT

Cast on 80 sts.

#### Lower Ribbing

**Rows 1-12:** \*K1, p1; repeat from \* to end of row.

Beginning with a wrong side (purl) row, work in Stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) for 35 rows.

#### Shape Top of Hat

**Row 1 (right side):** \*K2tog, k6; repeat from \* to end of row—70 sts.

**Row 2:** Purl.

**Row 3:** \*K2tog, k5; repeat from \* to end of row—60 sts.

**Row 4:** Purl.

**Row 5:** \*K2tog, k4; repeat from \* to end of row—50 sts.

**Row 6:** Purl.

**Row 7:** \*K2tog, k3; repeat from \* to end of row—40 sts.

**Row 8:** Purl.

**Row 9:** \*K2tog, k2; repeat from \* to end of row—30 sts.

**Row 10:** Purl.

**Row 11:** \*K2tog, k1; repeat from \* to end of row—20 sts.

**Row 12:** Purl.

**Row 13:** \*K2tog; repeat from \* to end of row—10 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing side edges together. Thread yarn tail through remaining 10 sts on needle, removing the sts from the knitting needle. Pull tail to gather top of hat. Use remainder of tail to sew side edges together.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es);  
\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
