## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™:** 1 ball each 8929 Strawberry **A**, 8690 Avocado **B**, 8001 Marshmallow **C**, 8012 Licorice **D**

**Susan Bates® Knitting**  
**Needles:** 5.0 mm [US 8]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 18 sts = 4" [10 cm];  
24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter  
Stitch (knit every row). Gauge  
is not critical for this pattern.  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use**  
**any size needle to obtain the**  
**gauge.**

# Polar Bear Scrubby Mitt

Sparkly yarn gives our washing mitt a festive fun vibe. Knit this clever fella to add a happy note to cleaning up after baking all the party cookies!

## NOTE

Carry yarn not in use up side of work unless otherwise instructed.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**Kfb** = Knit front and back of stitch (increase). knit 1 stitch in the front, then in the back loop. This is also called a Bar Increase.

**K2tog** = Knit 2 stitches together (decrease).

## MITT (make 2)

With **A**, cast on 27 sts.

**Rows 1-2:** With **A**, knit.

**Rows 3-4:** With **B**, knit.

Repeat Rows 1-4, four times.

**Rows 21-24:** With **A**, knit. At end of Row 24, fasten off yarn, change to **C**.

**Rows 25-33:** With **C**, knit.

**Row 34:** K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog—25 sts.

**Rows 35-38:** With **C**, knit.

**Row 39:** K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog—23 sts.

**Rows 40-43:** With **C**, knit.

**Row 44:** K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog—21 sts.

**Rows 45-48:** With **C**, knit.

**Row 49:** K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog—19 sts.

**Row 50:** Bind off all sts.

## EARS (make 2)

With **C**, cast on 3 stitches.

**Row 1:** Kfb in first and last stitch—5 sts.

**Rows 2-3:** Knit.

**Row 4:** Kfb in first and last stitch—7 sts.

**Rows 5-6:** Knit.

**Row 7:** Kfb in first and last stitch—9 sts.

**Row 8:** Bind off all sts. Cut yarn leaving a tail 15" [38 cm] long for attaching Ears.

## NOSE

With **D**, cast on 6 stitches.

**Row 1:** Knit.

**Row 2:** K2tog, K2, K2tog—4 sts.

**Row 3:** K2tog, K2tog—2 sts.

**Row 4:** Bind off all sts. Cut yarn leaving a tail 15" [38 cm] long for attaching Nose and embroidering "Mouth".

## FINISHING

With right side facing, using Yarn Needle and **A** and **C**, seam Mitt together. For facial features, use photo as a guide

## EARS

With yarn needle and **C**, sew ears to top corners of Mitt.

## NOSE

With yarn needle and **D**, sew nose to top center of Mitt over **C**. Sew to top layer only of Mitt.

## MOUTH

With yarn needle and **D**, embroider mouth on Mitt over **C**, centering mouth under the nose.

## EYES

With yarn needle and **D**, embroider eyes on Mitt over **C**, centering eyes above nose.

Weave in all ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A** = Strawberry; **B** = Avocado; **C** = Marshmallow; **D** = Licorice; **cm** = centimeters; **K** = knit; **Kfb** = knit front and back of stitch; **K2tog** = knit 2 stitches together; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **St st** = stockinette stitch; **St(s)** = stitch(es).



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
