

SUGAR BUSH RIBBED DOUBLE BRIM KNIT HAT *Designed by Destiny Meyer of Knifty Knittings | KNIT*



MATERIALS

Sugar Bush® Crisp™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 95 yds/87 m)
Provincial Peach (2025) **2 balls**

Bernat® Faux Fur Pompom White Rabbit (01005)

Sizes U.S. 6 (4 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) circular knitting needles 16" (40.5 cm) long. Set of four size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**. 8 stitch markers. Small quantity of scrap yarn. Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook (optional; used for provisional cast on).

 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Beginning

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

P = Purl

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

21 sts and 25 rnds = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st on larger needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller circular needle, provisionally cast on 96 sts with scrap yarn.

With working yarn, knit 1 rnd. Join to work in rnd, placing marker on first st.

1st rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.

Rep 1st rnd until work from beg measures 5" [12.5 cm].

Change to larger needle. Fold brim inwards and line up provisional cast on edge sts with live sts on needles.

Next rnd: Remove waste yarn from provisional cast on to expose 1 live st. Knit this st tog with first st on left needle. *Remove waste yarn from provisional cast on to expose 1 live st. Knit this st tog with next st on left needle. Rep from * around.

Knit in rnds until work from beg measures 6" [15 cm].

Crown decreases: 1st rnd: *K10. K2tog. PM. Rep from * around. 88 sts.

2nd rnd: Knit.

3rd rnd: *Knit to 2 sts before marker. K2tog. Rep from * around. 80 sts.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rnds 6 times more. 32 sts.

Next rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 16 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem 16 sts and fasten securely. Sew Pompom to top of Hat.
