## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
1 skein each 672 Spring Green A,  
368 Paddy Green B, and 316 Soft  
White C

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
3.75mm [F-5 US]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 4 sts = 1" (2.5 cm) in  
pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use  
any size hook to obtain the gauge.



**RED HEART® Super  
Saver®, Art. E300**  
available in solid color  
7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m);

# Shamrock Charm Necklace

*Get ready to enjoy having the “luck of the Irish” with this easy-to-crochet necklace. Shamrock and leprechaun hat charms are joined to crocheted chain for this fun Saint Patrick’s Day accessory!*

**Short necklace measures 26” (66 cm) long**  
**Long necklace measures 35” (89 cm) long**  
**Shamrock measures 2¼” (5.5 cm) long**  
**Hat measures 2” (5 cm) long**

## Special Stitch

CL (cluster) = Ch 3, yo, insert hook in indicated stitch, yo and pull up loop, yo, draw in 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook); [yo, insert hook in same stitch, yo and pull up loop, yo, draw in 2 loops] 2 times, yo, draw in all 4 loops on hook.

## Notes

1. Necklace is made from 2 sections joined together.
2. Four shamrock and hat motifs are joined to long necklace; 3 shamrocks are joined to short necklace.
3. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw in all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## SHAMROCK (make 7)

With **A**, ch 2.

**Round 1 (right side):** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc.

**Round 2:** CL in same st as join (leaf made), [slip st in next 2 st, CL in same st as last slip st made (leaf made)] twice, slip st in next st, ch 5, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch; join with slip st in first sc—3 leaves and 1 stem made. Fasten off.

## HAT

Working from top down, with **A**, ch 6.

**Row 1 (wrong side):** Ch 1, sc in each ch, turn—5 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn.

**Rows 3 and 4:** Repeat Row 2 twice; change to **B** at end of Row 4.

**Row 5:** Repeat Row 2 once; change to **A**.

**Row 6:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), 4 dc in first st, hdc in next 3 st, 5 dc in last st—13 sts. Fasten off.

## Buckle

With right side facing and **C**, backstitch a centered square on Row 5.

## LONG NECKLACE

With **B**, ch 48.

**Row 1:** With right sides facing and working in top of beginning ch of CL in center leaf of each shamrock, slip st in first shamrock, ch 13, slip st in next shamrock, ch 15, slip st in center st of top of hat, ch 15, slip st in next shamrock, ch 13, slip st in last shamrock, ch 48. Fasten off.

## SHORT NECKLACE

With **B**, ch 43.

**Row 1:** With right sides facing and working in top of beginning ch of CL in center leaf of each shamrock, slip st in first shamrock, [ch 13, slip st in next shamrock] twice, ch 43. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Ensure that necklace chains are not twisted. With right sides of motifs facing and short necklace positioned above long necklace, join all 4 ends of necklaces together. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
