



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

SIZE

One size to fit average woman's head.

GAUGE

Version 1: 12 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

Version 2: 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Version 1

Cast on 18 sts.

1st row (RS): *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 11" [28 cm], ending on a WS row.

Next row: C18F.

Next row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 22" [56 cm], ending on a WS row. Cast off in pat.

Sew ends tog.

Version 2

Cast on 24 sts.

1st row (RS): *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 11" [28 cm], ending on a WS row.

Next row: C24F.

Next row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 22" [56 cm], ending on a WS row. Cast off in pat.

Sew ends tog.

MATERIALS

Version 1

Bernat® Roving™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 120 yds/109 m)
Dark Grey (00044) **1 ball**

Version 2

Bernat® Super Value™ (7 oz/197 g; 426 yds/389 m)
Winter White (07407) **1 ball**

Version 1: Size U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Cable needle.

Version 2: Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Cable needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Beginning

C18F = Slip next 9 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. P1. (K1. P1) 4 times. [K1. (P1. K1) 4 times] from cable needle.

C24F = Slip next 12 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. (K1. P1) 6 times, then (K1. P1) 6 times from cable needle.

K = Knit

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat(ing)

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side
