



 CRAFT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" [20.5 cm] wide x 70" [178 cm] long.

GAUGE

5 stitches = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Right side of project is facing at all times. **Do not** turn work at end of rows.

Count 12 loops for foundation row.

1st row: Working from **right to left**, twist the 12th loop (last loop of foundation row) once to the left. Pull the 13th loop (from 'working yarn') up through 12th loop from behind to create a twisted st. Twist next loop (of foundation row) once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn up through next loop of foundation row. Continue in this manner to end of row. **Do not** turn work. 12 sts in row.

2nd row: Working from **left to right, with working yarn in front**, twist last st worked on previous row once to the left. Pull next loop

from working yarn up from behind through last st worked on previous row. *Twist next st once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next st. Repeat from * across row to end of row. **Do not** turn.

3rd row: Working from **right to left, with working yarn in back**, twist last st worked on previous row once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through last st worked on previous row. *Twist next st once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next st. Repeat from * across to end of row. **Do not** turn.

4th row: As 2nd row.

Begin working Cable pattern as follows:

5th row: Working from **right to left, with working yarn in back**, twist last st worked on previous row once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through last st worked on previous row. Twist next st once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next st.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Alize® Blanket-EZ™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 18 yds/16 m)
Cream (37013) **3 balls**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

St(s) = Stitch(es)

*Cross next st in front of 2nd st. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind 1st st. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind 2nd st. Repeat from * to last 2 sts. Twist next st once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next st over last 2 sts. **Do not** turn.

6th row: Working from **left to right with working yarn in front**, twist last st worked on previous row once to the left. Pull up next loop from working yarn towards back through last st worked on previous row. Twist next st once to the left. Pull up next loop from working yarn towards back through next st. **Bring working yarn to back**, *Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next st. Repeat from * to last 2 sts. **Bring working yarn to front**, twist next st once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next st over last 2 sts. **Do not** turn.

Repeat 5th and 6th rows for pattern until Scarf measures approx 68" [173 cm], ending on a 5th row.

Next row: As 2nd row.

Next row: As 3rd row.

Repeat last 2 rows once more.

Next row: As 2nd row.

Bind off row: Working in **same direction as last row**, pull 2nd st through 1st st. Pull 3rd st through 2nd st. Pull 4th st through 3rd st. Continue in this manner to end of row. Cut thread at base of loop (thread used to create the loop) to create a yarn 'tail'. Tie to secure and weave in end.
