



MATERIALS

Coats & Clark® Dual Duty XP® All-purpose Thread

Coats & Clark® All-purpose Zipper, 12" (30.48cm)

½ yd (45.72cm) floral print outer fabric

½ yd (45.72cm) coordinating lining fabric

½ yd (45.72cm) fusible fleece

Zipper foot

 SEWING | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

Featuring Coats & Clark® Polyester All Purpose Zipper

Whether you're serving a warm baguette with your vino, or just sipping it on its own, zip up the bottle with a Coats & Clark All-purpose Zipper to keep it chilled.

MEASUREMENTS

12" x 3½" (30.48cm x 8.89cm); fits a standard size wine bottle.

CUTTING

From each of the outer fabric, lining and fleece, cut:

(1) rectangle, 12½" x 11" (31.75cm x 27.94cm)

Note: If you're using a one-way print, the longer dimension is the height, so cut accordingly.

(1) 5" (12.70cm) square

From the outer fabric, cut:

(1) strip, 1 ¾" x 12" (4.45cm x 30.48cm), for binding

Seam allowances are ¼" (.64cm).

ASSEMBLING THE COZY

1. Draw a 4" (10.16cm) circle on the right side of the 5" (12.70cm) lining square. With wrong sides together, layer the squares of outer, fleece and lining fabrics. Sew just inside the marked line, then trim on the line.
2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the fleece to the outer rectangle wrong side.
3. With right sides together, pin the zipper to one long edge of the fused rectangle. Layer the lining right side down with the zipper between. Using a zipper foot, sew ¼" along the zipper edge.
4. Repeat step 3 with the opposite side of the zipper.

5. Turn right side out and press the fabrics away from the zipper teeth. Baste the upper edges of the rectangle together; repeat for the lower edge.
6. Mark the lower edge into quarters. Mark the layered circle into quarters.
7. With right sides together and matching the quarter marks, sew around the circle to attach the outer. Depending on how you inserted the zipper, you may need to ease the fabric to fit. Trim the seam allowances to 1/8" (.32cm) and zigzag around the seam allowances to finish.

FINISHING

1. Press the binding strip in half with wrong sides together. Matching the cut edges, place the binding right sides together on the upper outer edge. Stitch in place using a 1/8" (.32cm) seam.
2. Turn in both binding ends in to finish neatly, then hand-stitch the binding on the inside of the bag, covering the stitching line.
