

**MEN'S TILEWORK
TEXTURED PULLOVER**

SIZES

Chest measurement

Small 34-36 ins [86-91 cm]

Medium 38-40 ins [97-102 cm]

Large 42-44 ins [106.5-112 cm]

Extra-Large

46-48 ins [117-122 cm]

Finished chest

Small 43½ ins [110.5 cm]

Medium 47½ ins [120.5 cm]

Large 50½ ins [128.5 cm]

Extra-Large 54 ins [137 cm]

MATERIALS

Patons Classic Wool (100 g/3.5 oz)
or **Patons Décor** (100 g/3.5 oz)

Size	S	M	L	XL
	8	9	9	10 balls

Sizes 4 mm (U.S. 6) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** 2 st holders.

TENSION

20 sts and 26 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

BACK

**With smaller needles, cast on 103 (114-121-131) sts.

Knit 11 rows (garter st) noting that first row is WS, and inc 5 sts evenly across last row. 108 (119-126-136) sts.

Change to larger needles and work in stocking st until work from beg measures 9½ (10-10½-11) ins [24 (25.5-26.5-28) cm], ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Proceed as follows:

Foundation row: P6. *K6 (5-6-5). P12. Rep from * to last 12 (11-12-11) sts. K6 (5-6-5). P6.

1st row: (RS). K6. *P6 (5-6-5). K12. Rep from * to last 12 (11-12-11) sts. P6 (5-6-5). K6.

2nd row: P6. *K6 (5-6-5). P12. Rep from * to last 12 (11-12-11) sts. K6 (5-6-5). P6.

3rd row: K5. *P8 (7-8-7). K10. Rep from * to last 13 (12-13-12) sts. P8 (7-8-7). K5.

4th row: P4. *K2. P6 (5-6-5). K2. P8. Rep from * to last 14 (13-14-13) sts. K2. P6 (5-6-5). K2. P4.

5th row: K3. *P2. K8 (7-8-7). P2. K6. Rep from * to last 15 (14-15-14) sts. P2. K8 (7-8-7). P2. K3.

6th row: P2. *K2. P10 (9-10-9). K2. P4. Rep from * to last 16 (15-16-15) sts. K2. P10 (9-10-9). K2. P2.

7th row: P3. *K12 (11-12-11). P6. Rep from * to last 15 (14-15-14) sts. K12 (11-12-11). P3.

8th row: K3. *P12 (11-12-11). K6. Rep from * to last 15 (14-15-14) sts. P12 (11-12-11). K3.

9th row: K2. *P2. K10 (9-10-9). P2. K4. Rep from * to last 16 (15-16-15) sts. P2. K10 (9-10-9). P2. K2.

10th row: P3. *K2. P8 (7-8-7). K2. P6. Rep from * to last 15 (14-15-14) sts. K2. P8 (7-8-7). K2. P3.
11th row: K4. *P2. K6 (5-6-5). P2. K8. Rep from * to last 14 (13-14-13) sts. P2. K6 (5-6-5). P2. K4.
12th row: P5. *K8 (7-8-7). P10. Rep from * to last 13 (12-13-12) sts. K8 (7-8-7). P5.
Last 12 rows form pat.

Rep 1st to 12th rows once more, then 1st to 6th rows once. Knit 8 rows ending with RS facing for next row.
Rep from *** to *** once more.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: P0 (1-0-0). *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last 0 (1-0-0) st. P0 (1-0-0).**

Rep last 2 rows of seed st until work from beg measures 26 (27-28-29) ins [66 (69.5-71-73.5) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 18 (20-22-24) sts beg next 2 rows. then cast off 19 (21-22-24) sts beg following 2 rows. Leave rem 34 (37-38-40) sts on a st holder.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Cont in seed st until work from beg measures 23 (24-25-26) ins [58.5 (61-63.5-66) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Neck shaping: Pat across 46 (51-54-58) sts (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 9 (10-10-10) rows. 37 (41-44-48) sts. Cont even in seed st until work from beg measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 18 (20-22-24) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 19 (21-22-24) sts.

With RS of work facing slip next 16 (17-18-20) sts from spare needle onto a st holder. Join yarn to rem sts and work in seed st to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 9 (10-10-10) rows. 37 (41-44-48) sts.

Cont even in seed st until work from beg measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 18 (20-22-24) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 19 (21-22-24) sts.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles cast on 51 (48-51-48) sts.

Knit 11 rows noting first row is WS, and inc 3 sts evenly across last row. 54 (51-54-51) sts.

Change to larger needles and work 1st to 12th rows of pat as given for Back 7 times, AT SAME TIME, inc 1 st each end of needle on 5th and following 4th rows, taking inc sts into pat. 82 (79-82-79) sts.

Knit 8 rows. Beg with a knit row, cont in stocking st inc 1 st each end of next row and following 6th rows until there are 90 (95-100-105) sts.

Cont even in stocking st until sleeve from beg measures 21 (21½-22-22) ins [53 (54.5-56-56) cm], ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.



FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving to dry.

Neckband: Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 14 sts down left front neck edge. K16 (**17-18-20**) from front st holder. Pick up and knit 14 sts up right front neck edge. K34 (**37-38-40**) from back st holder. 78 (**82-84-88**) sts.

Knit 10 rows ending with **WS** facing for next row. Cast off.

Sew left shoulder and neckband seam. Place markers on front and back side edges 9 (**9½-10-10½**) ins [23 (**24-25.5-26.5**) cm] down from shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.



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
