## What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:**  
1 skein each 1101 Eggshell A  
and 1909 Holly Berry C

**RED HEART® Fur™:** 1 ball 9100  
Polar B

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks:**  
4mm [US G-6] and 6.5mm  
[US K-10½]

Yarn needle, black embroidery  
floss, sewing needle and white  
thread

**GAUGE:** 16 sc = 4" (10 cm);  
8 rows = 2" (5 cm) in single  
crochet with smaller hook.

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use  
any size hook to obtain the  
gauge.

# Happy Kids Reindeer Slippers

These slippers are a surefire way to keep the kids tootsies happy! They feature red noses, antlers and a fur edging for extra crochet coziness. Pattern is given with three sizes.

Directions are for size Toddler. Changes for sizes Child and Youth are in parentheses.

**Slippers measure 6 (7, 8)" [15 (18, 20.5) cm] long.**

## Notes

1. Each section is worked in joined rounds. Work all sections with smaller hook unless otherwise stated.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## Special Technique

**Join with sc =** Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

## SLIPPER (make 2) Sole

With smaller hook and **A**, ch 15 (19, 23).

**Round 1 (right side):** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 8 (10, 12) ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 3 (5, 7) ch, 5 dc in last ch (toe); working in opposite side of foundation ch, skip first ch, dc in next 3 (5, 7) ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next 8 (10, 12) ch, 2 sc in last ch; join with slip st in first sc—33 (41, 49) sts.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 (17, 21) sts, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 (17, 21) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc—39 (47, 55) sts.

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**Round 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 16 (20, 24) sts, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 16 (20, 24) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc—45 (53, 61) sts.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 18 (22, 26) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 18 (22, 26) sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc—53 (61, 69) sts.

**Round 5:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

### Foot Cover

With smaller hook and **A**, ch 29 (37, 45); taking care not to twist, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 1, sc in first 13 (17, 21) ch, 2 dc in next ch, 3 dc in next ch, 2 dc in next ch, sc in next 13 (17, 21) ch; join with slip st in first sc, turn—33 (41, 49) sts.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st around to last st, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc, turn—35 (43, 51) sts.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, sc in first 16 (20, 24) sts, 2 dc in next st, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, sc in next 16 (20, 24) sts; join with slip st in first sc, turn—39 (47, 55) sts.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc, turn.

**Round 5:** Ch 1, sc in first 17 (21, 25) sts, 2 dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in next 2 sts, sc in next 17 (21, 25) sts; join with slip st in first sc, turn—45 (53, 61) sts.

**Round 6:** Repeat Round 2—47 (55, 63) sts.

**Round 7:** Ch 1, sc in first 21 (25, 29) sts, 2 dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in next 2 sts, sc in next 21 (25, 29) sts; join with slip st in first sc—53 (61, 69) sts.

**Round 8:** Repeat Round 4.

**Round 9 (joining round):** With wrong sides of sole and foot cover held together, matching sts, and working through both thicknesses, ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

### Fur Trim

**Round 1:** With larger hook, join **B** with sc in any st, sc in each remaining st around; join with slip st in first st. Fasten off.

## REINDEER

### Head

With smaller hook and **A**, ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first st—8 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first 7 sts; leave remaining sts unworked—14 sc. Fasten off.

### Nose

With smaller hook and **B**, ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first st—6 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; change to **A**—12 sc.

**Row 3:** Hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st; leave remaining sts unworked—5 sts. Fasten off.

### Antler (make 2)

With smaller hook and **A**, ch 4.

**Round 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; join with slip st in first sc—3 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc.

Repeat Round 2 until antler measures 1½". Fasten off.

Branch

**Row 1:** With side of antler facing, join **A** with sc in any st just past midpoint nearer to top, sc in next st, turn—2 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With wrong sides held together, center Row 3 of nose under Row 2 of head and sew pieces together.

Sew antlers to each side of head.

Referring to photograph as a guide, embroider French knot eyes with black embroidery floss. With white thread and sewing needle, sew completed head to front of foot cover.

Weave in ends.

**A, B, C** = Color **A**, Color **B**, Color **C**, etc.;  
**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet;  
**st(s)** = stitch(es).
