



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

K = Knit

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 18" [46 cm] wide x 70" [178 cm] long.

GAUGE

14 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). With A, knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 59 sts.

2nd row: Knit.

3rd and 4th rows: With B, knit.

Rep last 4 rows until there are 5 sts rem. Cast off.

INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 5 sts.

1st row: Knit.

2nd and 3rd rows: With B, knit.

4th row: (RS). With A, knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 6 sts.

5th row: Knit.

6th and 7th rows: With B, knit.

Rep last 4 rows until there are 60 sts.

MATERIALS

RED HEART® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Contrast A Black (0312) **1 ball**

RED HEART® Super Saver Stripes™ (5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m)

Contrast B Polo Stripe (4960) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
