

## BERNAT® KNIT TRIANGLES HEXAGON BLANKET



### MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

**Contrast A** Coal (10040)      **3 balls or 565 yds/517 m**

**Contrast B** Vintage White (10006)      **2 balls or 431 yds/394 m**

**Contrast C** Burnt Mustard (10874)      **1 ball or 206 yds/188 m**

**Contrast D** Light Teal (10734)      **1 ball or 160 yds/146 m**

**Bernat® Blanket Brights™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

**Contrast E** Pixie Pink (12008)      **1 ball or 217 yds/198 m**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Tapestry needle. Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook for fringe.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Cont** = Continue

**K** = Knit

**K2(3)tog** = Knit next 2(3) stitches together

**Kfb** = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 54" x 62" [137 x 157.5 cm], excluding fringe.

### GAUGE

7 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Notes:

- Blanket is made with 6 Strips (see diagram on page 2). Strips are sewn tog in Finishing.
- Base Triangle of each Strip is cast on and knit back and forth across needle. Each additional Triangle begins by picking up sts along the edge of previous Triangle.

- While working striped Base Triangle/Triangle from diagram, cont in Stripe pat until Base Triangle/Triangle is complete.

#### Stripe A-B

With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe A-B pat.

#### Stripe A-C

With A, work 2 rows.

With C, work 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe A-C pat.

#### Stripe A-D

With A, work 2 rows.

With D, work 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe A-D pat.

### Stripe A-E

With A, work 2 rows.

With E, work 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe A-E pat.

### Base Triangle

Using appropriate color/Stripe pat for each Strip (see diagram), work back and forth across needle in rows as follows:

Cast on 22 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). Knit.

**\*\*2nd row:** K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 21 sts.

**3rd row:** Knit.

**4th row:** Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 20 sts.

Rep last 4 rows until 4 sts rem.

**Next row:** K4.

**Next row:** K1. K2tog. K1. 3 sts.

**Next row:** K3.

**Next row:** K3tog. Fasten off.\*\*

### Triangle

Using appropriate color/Stripe pat (see diagram), and with RS facing, pick up and knit 22 sts evenly along edge of previous Triangle.

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Base Triangle.

Using appropriate color/Stripe pat (see diagram), cont working Triangles to complete each Strip.

### FINISHING

Following diagram, sew 6 Strips tog.

**Edging:** With RS facing and A, pick up and knit 66 sts evenly along any edge of Blanket.

**1st row:** (WS). K1. Kfb. Knit to end of row.

**2nd row:** Knit.

**3rd row:** Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. Cast off leaving a tail approx 12" [30.5 cm] long.

Rep across rem 5 edges of Blanket. Using leftover tails, sew sides of Edging tog.

**Fringe:** Cut strands of both A and B 10" [25.5 cm] long. Taking 1 strand, fold in half and knot into fringe through each st of edging around entire Blanket, alternating A and B strands (as shown in photo). Trim fringe evenly.
