Stitch markers.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Notes

Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc.
When joining new color, work to last loops on hook of last st. Draw new color through loops, then proceed in new color.

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## \# Patons sLanted and enchanted crochet sweater| CROCHET

## FRONT

**With A, ch 74 (82-92-98-116-126). 1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3 rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 72 (80-90-96-114-124) hdc.
2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in first hdc. *Hdcfp around next hdc. Hdcbp around next hdc. Rep from * to last hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn. Rep last row twice more.

Next row: (RS). Ch 2.1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until work from beg measures approx $63 / 4(51 / 2-51 / 2-51 / 2-$ 7-6)" [17 (14-14-14-18-15) cm], ending on a WS row.**

Beg color-blocking:
1st row: (RS). With B, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 3 (3-3-3-3-4) h dc. With $A, 1$ hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
2nd row: With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each of next 69 (77-87-93-111120) hdc. With B, 1 hdc in each of next 3 (3-3-3-3-4) hdc. Turn.
3rd row: With $B$, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 6 (6-6-6-7-8) hdc. With A, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

4th row: With $A$, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 66 (74-84-90-107116) hdc. With B, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
5th row: With B, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 9 (9-9-9-11-12) hdc. With $A, 1$ hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
6th row: With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 63 (71-81-87-103112) hdc. With B, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
7th row: With B, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 12 (12-12-12-1516) hdc. With $A, 1$ hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
8th row: With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 60 (68-78-84-99108) hdc. With B, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
Cont as established, working 3 (3-3-3-4-4) more hdc in B every other row until there are 66 (75-81-87-111-120) hdc worked in $B$ and 6 (5-9-9-3-4) hdc worked in A, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## BACK

Work from ** to ** as given for Front.

Beg color-blocking:
1st row: (RS). With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 69 (77-87-93-111120) hdc. With $B, 1$ hdc in each of next 3 (3-3-3-3-4) hdc. Turn.
2nd row: With B, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 3 (3-3-3-3-4) hdc. With A, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 66 (74-84-90-107116) hdc. With B, 1 hdc in each of next 6 (6-6-6-7-8) hdc. Turn.
4th row: With B, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 6 (6-6-6-7-8) hdc. With A, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
5th row: With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 63 (71-81-87-103112) hdc. With B, 1 hdc in each of next 9 (9-9-9-11-12) hdc. Turn.
6th row: With $B$, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 9 (9-9-9-11-12) hdc. With $A, 1$ hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
7th row: With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each of first 60 (68-78-84-99108) hdc. With $B, 1$ hdc in each of next 12 (12-12-12-15-16) hdc. Turn.

Cont as established, working 3 (3-3-3-4-4) more hdc in B every other row until there are 66 (75-81-87-111-120) hdc worked in B and 6 (5-9-9-3-4) hdc worked in A, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## SLEEVE

(Make 1 each in A and B)
Ch 36 (36-38-40-40-44).
1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3 rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 34 (34-36-38-38-42) hdc.
2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in first hdc. *Hdcfp around next hdc. Hdcbp around next hdc. Rep from * to last hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.
Rep last row twice more.

## Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 2.2 hdc in first st. 1 hdc in each st to last st. 2 hdc in last st. Turn. 36 (36-38-40-4044) hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn
Rep last 2 rows 13 (16-17-18-1920) times more. 62 (68-72-76-7884) hdc.

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Next row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until Sleeve from beg measures approx 17 " $[43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.
Sew shoulder seams 4 (4½-51/2-61/4-8-10)" [10 (11.5-14-16-20.525.5) cm] in from each armhole edge. Place markers 8 ( $8^{1 / 2}-9-$ 9½-10-101/2)" [20.5 (21.5-23-24-$25.5-26.5$ ) cm ] down from each shoulder. Sew in sleeves between markers, centering sleeve at shoulder and noting B sleeve will be Right Sleeve and A sleeve will be Left Sleeve. Sew side and sleeve seams

Neck edging: With RS facing, join $B$ with sl st at left shoulder seam. Ch 1.Work 1 rnd of scevenly around neck opening. Join with sl st to first sc . Fasten off.


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
