XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]

L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]

4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished chest

XS/S 36" [91.5 cm]

M 40" [101.5 cm]

L 44" [112 cm]

2/3XL 56" [142 cm]

4/5XL 60" [152.5 cm]

GAUGES

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

14 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook in Moss St Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® Brushed™ (5 oz/142 g; 255 yds/233 m)

Sizes XS/S M L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL

Main Color (MC)

Cream (0510) 4 4 5 5 5 6 **balls**

Contrast A

Dusty Pink (5071) 1 1 1 1 1 1 **ball**

Sizes U.S. H/8 (5 mm) and U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® stitch markers. 4 (4-4-4-5-5) 1¼" [3 cm] buttons. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

BODY

Note: Body is worked in one piece to armholes.

Ribbing: With smaller hook and MC, ch 9.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. 8 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Ribbing, when slightly stretched, measures **36 (40-44-48-56-60)" [91.5 (101.5-112-122-142-152.5) cm]**, ending on a RS row. **Do not** fasten off.

Turn Ribbing sideways.

Change to larger hook and working across long side, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in corner of ribbing. Work (Ch 1. 1 sc) **63 (70-77-84-98-105)** times evenly across. Turn. **127 (141-155-169-197-211)** sts (sc and ch-1).

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sts (ch-1 sp and sc). 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. Rep last 2 rows for Moss St Pat until work from beg measures approx **10 (10-10-11-12-13)" [25.5 (25.5-25.5-28-30.5-33) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

Right Front: Shape V-neck and armhole:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. (Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp) **14 (15-17-19-22-24)** times. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **29 (31-35-39-45-49)** sts (sc and ch 1).

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. **27 (29-33-37-43-47)** sts.

Rep last row **4 (4-4-6-8-10)** times more. **19 (21-25-25-27-27)** sts.

Shape V-neck only:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. **17 (19-23-23-25-25)** sts.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Work even in pat. Rep last 2 rows **7 (7-9-9-9-9)** times more. **9 (11-13-13-15-15)** sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures **7½ (8-9-10-10½-11)" [19 (20.5-23-25.5-26.5-28) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Back: Shape armholes: With RS facing, skip next **5 (7-7-7-9-9)** sts (sc and ch 1). Join yarn with sl st to next ch-1 sp.

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. (Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp) **29 (32-35-38-44-47)** times. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **59 (65-71-77-89-95)** sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.

Rep last row **4 (4-4-6-8-10)** times more. **49 (55-61-63-71-73)** sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures 2 rows less than Front.

Shape Neck: 1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Pat across first **9 (11-13-13-15-15)** sts. Sc2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. **9 (11-13-13-15-15)** sts. Fasten off.

With RS facing, skip next **27 (29-31-33-37-39)** sts. Join yarn with sl st to next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Fasten off.

Left Front: Shape V-neck and armhole:

With RS facing, skip next **5 (7-7-7-9-9)** sts (sc and ch 1). Join yarn with sl st to next ch-1 sp.

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. (Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp) **14 (15-17-19-22-24)** times (end of row). Turn. **29 (31-35-39-45-49)** sts (sc and ch 1).

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. **27 (29-33-37-43-47)** sts.

Rep last row **4 (4-4-6-8-10)** times more. **19 (21-25-25-27-27)** sts.

Shape V-neck only: 1st row: (RS). Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn. **17 (19-23-23-25-25)** sts.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.
2nd row: Work even in pat. Rep last 2 rows **7 (7-9-9-9-9)** times more. **9 (11-13-13-15-15)** sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures **7½ (8-9-10-10½-11)" [19 (20.5-23-25.5-26.5-28) cm]**, ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

Ribbing: With smaller hook and MC, ch 9.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. 8 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until work, when slightly stretched, measures **10 (10½-11-11½-12-13½)" [25.5 (26.5-28-29-30.5-34.5) cm]**, ending on a RS row. **Do not** fasten off.

Body of Sleeve: Turn Ribbing sideways.

Change to larger hook and working across long side, proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in corner of ribbing. Work (Ch 1. 1 sc) **17 (18-19-20-21-24)** times evenly across. Turn. **35 (37-39-41-43-49)** sts (sc and ch 1).

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last ch-1 sp and sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: (Inc row). Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. **37 (39-41-43-45-51)** sts.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last ch-1 sp and sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

6th row: As 4th row.

7th row: (RS – Inc row). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Ch 1. *1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last ch-1 sp and sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. **39 (41-43-45-47-53)** sts.

8th and 9th rows: Rep 5th and 6th rows.

10th row: As 5th row. Rep 3rd to 10th rows until there are **43 (45-47-49-63-69)** sts.

Sizes XS/S, M, L, XL only: Cont in pat as established inc 1 st each end of following 6th rows from previous inc until there are **53 (55-57-59)** sts.

All sizes: Cont even in pat until work from beg measures **17 (17-18-18-17-16)" [43 (43-45.5-45.5-43-40.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Shape Top: 1st row: (RS). Skip first 3 sts (sc, ch 1, sc). Join MC with sl st to next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 3 sts (sc, ch 1, sc). **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **47 (49-51-53-57-59)** sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last ch-1 sp and sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.

4th row: Work even in pat. Rep last 2 rows **3 (4-5-6-7-8)** times more. **39 (39-39-39-41-41)** sts.

Next row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. Rep last row 8 times more. **21 (21-21-23-23)** sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Button and Buttonhole Band:

Sew shoulder seams. With smaller hook and MC, ch 7.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. 6 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row, until band, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit up Left Front and around neck edge, sewing in place as you work.

PM for **4 (4-4-4-5-5)** buttons, having bottom button 1" [2.5 cm] up from bottom, top button at beg of V-shaping and rem **2 (2-2-2-3-3)** buttons spaced evenly between.

Work buttonholes as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 2 sc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 sc. 1 scbl in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 2 sc. 2 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 scbl in each of last 2 sc. Turn. 6 sc.

Cont working front band until work, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit down Right Front, noting button holes to correspond to button markers and sewing in place as you work. Fasten off. Sew sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

FLOWERS (make 20)

With smaller hook and A, ch 3.

1st rnd: 1 sc in 3rd ch from hook (counts as (sc, ch 1, sc)). (Ch 1. 1 sc) 5 times in 3rd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first ch-1 sp.

2nd rnd: *Ch 3. (Yoh and draw up a loop maintaining length of ch 3) 5 times in same sp as sl st. Yoh and draw up a loop through 10 loops on hook. Yoh and draw through rem 2 loops on hook. Ch 3. Sl st in same ch-1 sp as st just made.** Sl st in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * 4 times more, then from * to ** once. Fasten off.



Sew on Flowers randomly as shown on Fronts and Sleeves in picture.
