



MATERIALS

Coats & Clark™ Dual Duty XP® All-purpose Thread

Coats & Clark™ Jeans Topstitching Thread

Coats & Clark™ All-purpose Zipper, 16" (41cm)

5/8 yd (57cm) linen or linen-like fabric

1/3 yd (30.5cm) sew-in foam stabilizer or thick batting

14" x 20" (35.5cm x 51cm) pillow form

90/14 Topstitching needle

Tear-away stabilizer (optional)

Sharp-pointed trimming scissors

Removable fabric marker

Zipper foot

 SEWING | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

Simple is sometimes best. Use trapunto, the quilting technique of raising a design with extra stuffing, to emphasize the letters spelling HOME and create this elegantly simple pillow. Coats & Clark™ Jeans Topstitching thread makes the stitching more prominent.

MEASUREMENTS

14" x 20" (35.5cm x 51cm)

CUTTING

From the linen fabric, cut:

(1) rectangle, 14½" x 20½" (37cm x 52cm), for pillow front

(2) strips, 8¼" x 20½" (21cm x 52cm), for pillow back

Seam allowances are ½" (1.5cm).

ASSEMBLING THE PILLOW BACK

1. With right sides together, sew a 1" (2.5cm) seam to join the long edges of the strips. Sew with a regular length stitch for 2¼" (5.5cm) on each end of the seam and use a basting stitch length between. Press the seam open.
2. Following Coats & Clark instructions in the zipper package, create a lapped or centered zipper application. Remove the basting threads.

ASSEMBLING THE PILLOW **FRONT**

1. Transfer the letters and home outline to the pillow front, centering it in both directions. This can be done using a removable marking pen, or by tracing the images onto tear-away stabilizer. Choose the method you're most comfortable with, based on the surface texture of your fabric.
2. Place a square of foam (or batting) behind the image location and pin in place. The foam needs to be slightly larger than the image.
3. Thread the machine with Coats & Clark™ Topstitching thread on top and all purpose thread in the bobbin. If you traced directly onto the fabric, stitch around the letters and house image using Topstitching Thread. Bring the thread ends to the underside and tie off. If you're using tear-away stabilizer, center the image on the pillow right side, stitch the outlines, then carefully remove the stabilizer as directed by the manufacturer.

4. Using sharp-pointed scissors, carefully trim the foam around each letter and the house image just outside the stitching line.

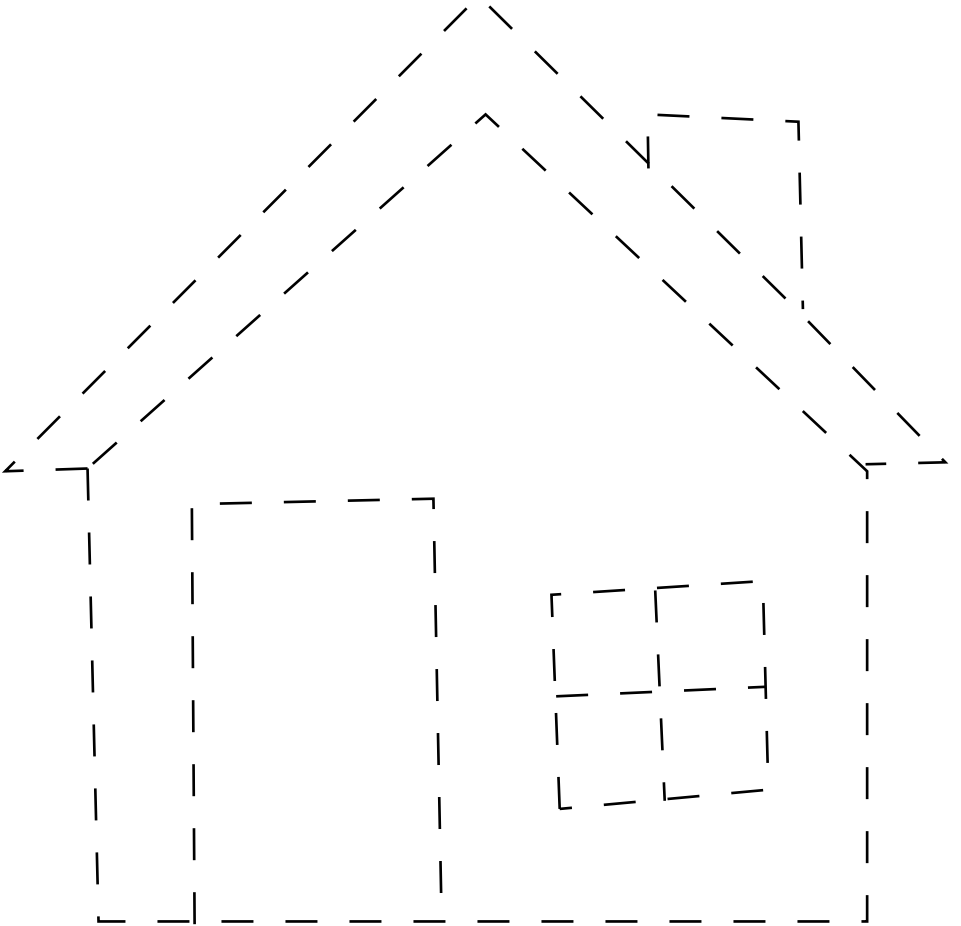
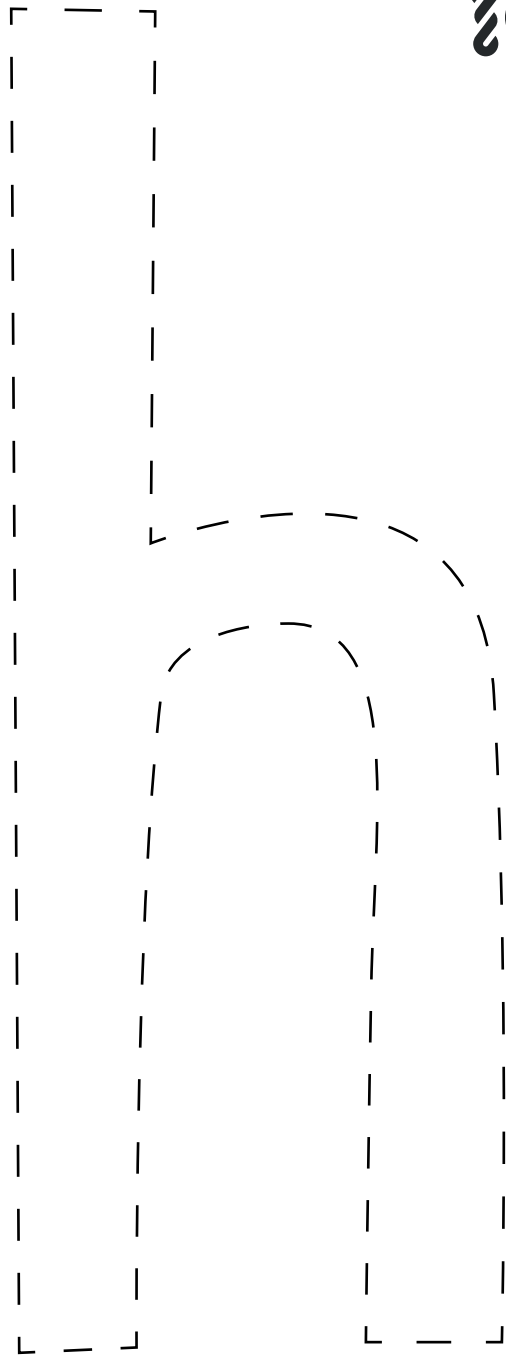
ASSEMBLING THE PILLOW

1. Place the pillow front and back right sides together, matching raw edges and with the zipper partially open. Sew around the perimeter using a ½" (1.5cm) seam allowance.
2. Clip the corners to reduce bulk, trim the seam allowances and zigzag the edges together, then turn the pillow cover right side out through the zipper opening. Gently push out the corners and press the pillow cover edges.

FINISHING

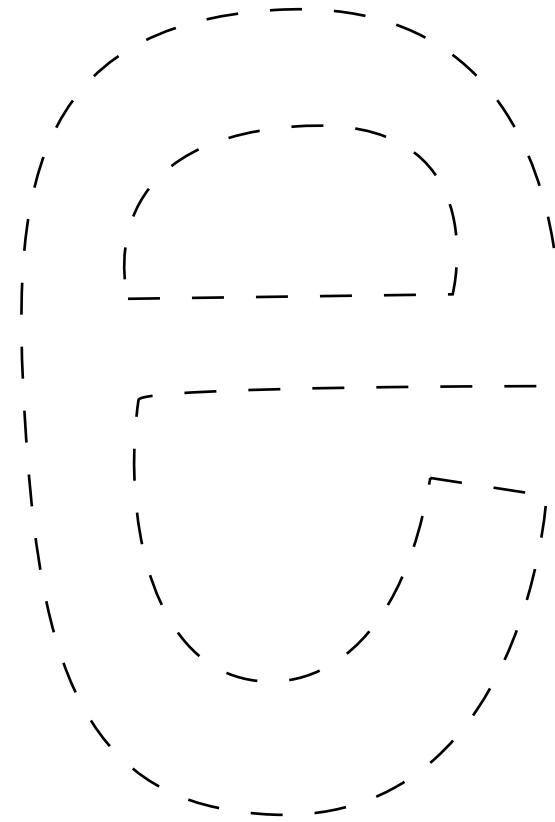
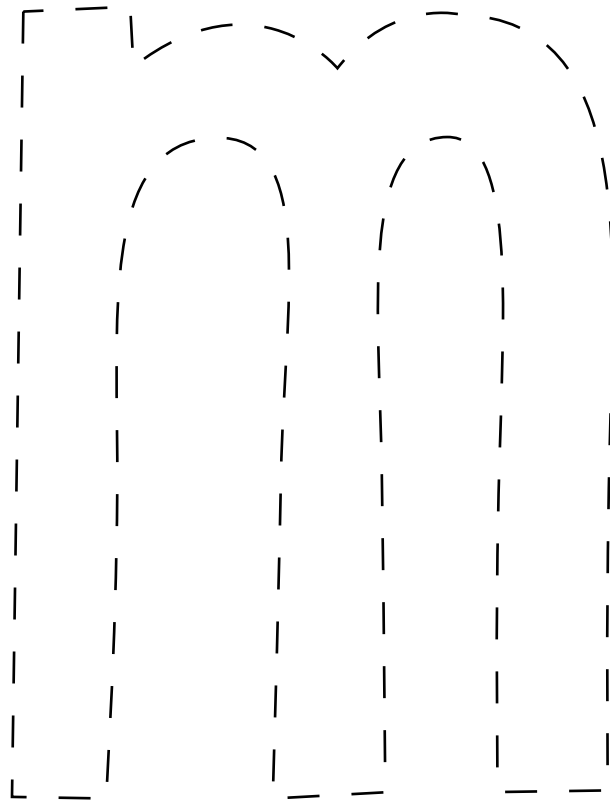
Insert the pillow form through the zipper opening.
