MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ O'Go™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)
Milk and Honey (42005) **6 O'Gos**



Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Hdc = Half double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 54" [137 cm] wide x 62" [157.5 cm] long.

GAUGE

6 dc and 3½ rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start crocheting!

Ch 95.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 93 dc.

2nd row: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dcfp around next st. 1 hdc in last st. Turn.

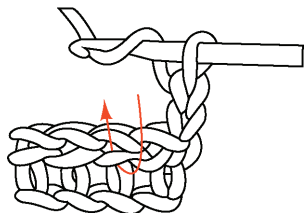
3rd row: Ch 2. *1 dcbp around next st. 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dcbp around next st. 1 hdc in last st. Turn.

4th and 5th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows.

6th row: As 2nd row.

7th row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

8th to 14th rows: Ch 2. 1 hdc in horizontal bar created below stitch in previous row (bar is below loops worked on WS – see diagram below) in each hdc to last hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.



15th row: Ch 2. 1 dc in horizontal bar created below stitch in previous row in each hdc to last st. 1 hdc in last st. Turn.

Rep 2nd to 15th rows for pat until Blanket from beg measures approx 62" [157.5 cm], ending on a 6th row. Fasten off.
