What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 1 ball
930 Marble

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical
for this project.

Scrubby Bottle Washer

This Scrubby conveniently fits onto the handle of a wooden spoon making quick work of cleaning into jars and smaller containers. After using, you can remove it from the spoon, put it in the washing machine and have a fresh and clean Scrubby.

**Scrubby measures 4" wide and 7" long
(10 x 18 cm).**

Special Stitches

Bpdc (back post double crochet) =

Yarn over, insert hook from back side of work to front and to back again around the post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook). Skip the stitch "in front of" the Bpdc.

Fpdc (front post double crochet) =

Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook).

sc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Notes

1. Scrubby is worked in joined rounds with right side facing at all times.
2. When instructed to work into a stitch "2 rounds below", work into the round numbered 2 less than the current row. For example, if you are working Round 14, a stitch "2 rounds below" is in Row 14 - 2 = Round 12.

SCRUBBY

Ch 17.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; taking care not to twist, join with slip st in first sc—16 sts.

Round 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st here or throughout), hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first hdc.

Round 3: Ch 2, Fpdc around first st, Bpdc around next st, *Fpdc around next st, Bpdc around next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first dc.

Round 4: Ch 2, Bpdc around first st, Fpdc around next st, *Bpdc around next st, Fpdc around next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first dc.

Rounds 5-12: Repeat Rounds 3 and 4.

Round 13: (Ch 6, slip st) around post of each st around; join with slip st in first slip st.

Round 14: Ch 2, hdc in each slip st; join with slip st in first hdc.

Rounds 15-18: Repeat Rounds 13 and 14 twice.

Round 19: Repeat Round 13.

Round 20: Ch 1, sc in each slip st; join with slip st in first sc.

Rounds 21 and 22: Ch 1, [sc2tog] around; join with slip st in first sc—4 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Weave tail through last round, pull tightly to close and secure.

Sew first and last st of Round 1 together with beginning tail.

Weave in ends.

Slide open end over handle of large spoon or kitchen utensil.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
