



# Knit Mitered Jacket

**Directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium, Large, X-Large and 2X are in parentheses.**

**Finished Bust:** 39 (43, 47, 51, 55)”.  
**Finished Length:** 23 (24, 25, 26, 26)”.

**RED HEART® “Eco-Ways™”:** 10 (12, 14, 15, 16) in 3114 Chamois.

**Knitting Needle:** 8mm [US 11] circular, 32” long.  
Stitch markers.  
Stitch holders.  
Yarn needle.  
One 1½” button (optional).

**GAUGE:** 12 sts = 4”; 18 rows = 4” in garter st using 2 strands of yarn held together. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
**Use any size needles to obtain the specified gauge.**

**NOTE:** Use 2 strands of yarn together throughout. Pieces are knit back and forth in rows. Circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

## Special Abbreviations

**K1-f/b** = Knit in the front and back loop of next st – 1 st increased.

## BACK

With 2 strands of yarn held together, cast on 58 (64, 70, 76, 82) sts.  
Work in garter st for 37 rows.

### Shape Armhole

Bind off 12 (15, 18, 21, 24) sts at beginning of next 2 rows – 34 sts.  
Work in garter st until Armhole measures 15 (16, 17, 18, 18)” from beginning.  
Bind off.

## LEFT FRONT

With 2 strands of yarn held together, cast on 60 (65, 70, 75, 80) sts.  
**Next Row (Wrong Side):** K30 (32, 34, 36, 38), place marker, k30 (33, 36, 39, 42).  
**Next Row (Right Side):** Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, ssk, knit to last st, k1-f/b – 59 (64, 69, 74, 79) sts.  
**Next Row:** K1-f/b, knit across row – 60 (65, 70, 75, 80) sts; 31 (33, 35, 37, 39) sts before marker; 29 (32, 35, 38, 41) sts after marker.  
Repeat last 2 rows 8 more times, with marker moving 1 st over, until there are 48 (49, 51, 54, 55) sts before marker and 12 (15, 18, 21, 24) sts after marker on last wrong side row.

### Shape Armhole

Bind off 12 (15, 18, 21, 24) sts, slip remaining 48 (50, 52, 54, 56) sts to stitch holder for Sleeve.

## RIGHT FRONT

With 2 strands of yarn held together, cast on 60 (65, 70, 75, 80) sts.



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**Next Row (Wrong Side):** K30 (33, 36, 39, 42), place marker, k30 (32, 34, 36, 38).

**Next Row (Right Side):** K1-f/b, knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, ssk, knit to end of row – 59 (64, 69, 74, 79) sts.

**Next Row:** Knit to last st, k1-f/b – 60 (65, 70, 75, 80) sts; 29 (32, 35, 38, 41) sts before marker; 31 (33, 35, 37, 39) sts after marker.

Work as for Left Front, reversing shaping.

**LEFT SLEEVE**

With right side facing and holding 2 strands of yarn together, work across 48 (50, 52, 54, 56) sts from Left Front stitch holder, pick up and knit 48 (50, 52, 54, 56) sts evenly spaced along Left Armhole edge of Back, leaving bind-off sts unworked – 96 (100, 104, 108, 112) sts.

Work in St st for 4 (5, 6, 7, 8)”, ending with a wrong side row.

Bind off 20 (21, 22, 23, 24) sts at beginning of next 2 rows – 56 (58, 60, 62, 64) sts.

Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then 1 st at beginning of next 4 rows – 42 (44, 46, 48, 50) sts.

Work even in until Sleeve measures 20 (21, 22, 23, 24)” from beginning.

Work in garter st for 2”.

Bind off.

**RIGHT SLEEVE**

Work as for Left Sleeve, reversing shaping.

**COLLAR**

Cast on 140 sts.

**Next Row (Wrong Side):** K10, place marker, knit to last 10 sts, place marker, k10.

**Decrease Row:** Knit to 2 sts before first marker, k2tog, ssk, knit to 2 sts before 2nd marker, k2tog, ssk, knit to end – 136 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Repeat last 2 rows 8 more times – 104 sts.

Bind off.

**FINISHING**

Sew edges of Sleeves to bind-off sts of Armhole on Fronts and Back. Sew side and Sleeve seams. With right side of Collar facing wrong side of Fronts and Back and beginning and ending at first increased st on Fronts, sew bind-off edge of Collar around Neck edge of Fronts and Back. Fold Collar over to right side of Jacket.

**BUTTON LOOP (optional)**

With yarn held single, cast on 16 st.

Bind off sts. Sew onto Right side of jacket at beginning of collar. Sew button to opposite side.

Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **K** = Knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **Ssk** = slip 2 sts one at a time knitwise, knit slipped sts together through back loop; **st(s)** = stitch(es).





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
