What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Soft Baby Steps ${ }^{\oplus}$ : $2(2,2,2)$ balls 9401 Elephant

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Knitting Needles: 4.5 mm [US 7] and 5 mm [US 8]

Stitch markers, six 3/4" (19 mm) buttons, yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts $=4$ " (10 cm); 23 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$, in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). CHECK YOUR GAUGE Use any size needles to the obtain gauge.

RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Soft Baby Steps ${ }^{\circledR}$, Art. E 746 available in solid color $50 z(141 \mathrm{~g}), 256 \mathrm{yd}(234 \mathrm{~m})$ prints 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd ( 187 m ) balls


## Baby Lace Cardigan

This comfy raglan style sweater features a pretty pattern of knitted lace on each front. The neutral grey blends fashionably with all the colors in baby's wardrobe.

Directions are for size 6-12 months.
Changes for sizes 12-24 months (2-3 years,
3-5 years) are in parentheses
To Fit Chest: 16-18 (18-20, 20-22, 22-24)" (40.5-45.5 (45.5-51, 51-56, 56-61) cm)

Finished Chest: $22(24,26,28)$ " $56(61,66$, 71) cm)

Finished Length: 12 ( $12^{1 ⁄ 2}, 13^{1 ⁄ 2}, 14$ )" $(30.5$
$(32,34.5,35.5) \mathrm{cm})$

## Special Stitches

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) - Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.
s2k1p2 = Slip 2 stitches as if to k2tog, k1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over the knit stitch and off the needle - 2 sts decreased. ssk = Slip next 2 stitches as if to knit to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

## Pattern Stitches

Seed Stitch (over an odd number of sts)
Row 1: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2: Knit the purl sts and purl the knit sts as they appear.
Repeat Row 2 for Seed st.
Little Arrowhead Lace (worked over 5 sts)
Row 1 (right side): Yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo.
Row 2: Purl.
Row 3: K1, yo, s2k1p2, yo, k1.
Row 4: Purl.
Repeat Rows 1-4 for Little Arrowhead Lace

## BACK

With smaller needles, cast on $47(51,55,59)$ sts.
Work in Seed st for 8 rows.
Change to larger needles.

Work in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) until piece measures $73 / 4$ (8, $81 / 2,83 / 4$ )" (19.5 (20.5, 21.5, 22) cm) from beginning; end with a wrong side row.

## Shape Raglan Armholes

Row 1 (right side): Bind off 2 sts, knit to end of row-45 $(49,53,57)$ sts.
Row 2: Bind off 2 sts, purl to last 2 sts, k2$43(47,51,55)$ sts.
Row 3 (decrease row): P2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, p2-41 (45, 49, 53) sts.
Row 4: K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.
Repeat last 2 rows $9(10,11,12)$ more times-23 $(25,27,29)$ sts.
Work even in Stockinette st until armholes measure $41 / 4\left(4 \frac{1}{2}, 5,51 / 4\right)$ " (10.5 (11.5, 12.5, $13.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ); end with a wrong side row. Bind off.

## LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on $29(31,33,35)$ sts.
Work in Seed st for 8 rows.
Change to larger needles.

## Begin Lace Pattern

Row 1 (right side): K15 (17, 19, 21), [p1, k1] twice, place marker, work Row 1 of Little Arrowhead Lace, place marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice.
Row 2: K1, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work Row 2 of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, [k1, p1] twice, purl to end of row.
Row 3: Knit to 4 sts before marker, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work Row 3 of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice.
Row 4: K1, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work Row 4 of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, [k1, p1] twice, purl to end of row.

Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures $73 / 4$ $(8,81 / 2,834)^{\prime \prime}(19.5(20.5,21.5,22) \mathrm{cm})$ from beginning; end with a wrong side row.

## Shape Raglan Armhole

Row 1 (right side): Bind off 2 sts, knit to 4 sts before marker, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work next row of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice-27 (29, 31, 33) sts.
Row 2: K1, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work next row of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, [k1, p1] twice, purl to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 3 (decrease row): P2, k2tog, knit to 4 sts before marker, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work next row of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice- $26(28,30,32)$ sts. Repeat last 2 rows $7(8,9,10)$ more times-19 (20, 21, 22) sts.

## Shape Neck

Remove markers as you work the next row. Row 1 (wrong side): Bind off $7(8,8,9)$ sts, purl to last $9(10,11,12)$ sts, $[k 1, \mathrm{p} 1]$ twice, p3 (4, 5, 6), k2-12 ( $12,13,13$ ) sts.
Row 2 (right side): P2, k2tog, k1 (2, 3, 4), p1, k1, p1, k2 (1, 1, 0), k2tog-10 (10, 11, 11) sts. Row 3: P2 (1, 1, 2), [k1, p1] $2(2,2,1)$ time(s), p2 (3, 4, 5), k2.

Size 6-12 months only:
Row 4 (right side): P2, k2tog, [p1, k1] twice,
k2tog-8 sts.
Row 5: P3, k1, p2, k2.
Size 12-24 months only:
Row 4 (right side): P2, k2tog, [k1, p1] twice, k2tog-8 sts.
Row 5: P2, k1, p3, k2.

Size 2-3 years only:
Row 4 (right side): P2, k2tog, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2tog- 9 sts.
Row 5: P2, k1, p4, k2.

## Size $3-5$ years only:

Row 4 (right side): P2, k2tog, k3, p1, k1,
k2tog-9 sts.
Row 5: P1, k1, p5, k2.

## All Sizes:

Work even in Stockinette st until armholes measure $41 / 4(4112,5,51 ⁄ 4)^{\prime \prime}$ ( 10.5 (11.5, 12.5, $13.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ); end with a wrong side row. Bind off.

## RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on $29(31,33,35)$ sts.
Work in Seed st for 8 rows.
Change to larger needles.

## Begin Lace Pattern

Row 1 (buttonhole row - right side): K1, yo,
k2tog (buttonhole made), p1, k1, place marker, work Row 1 of Little Arrowhead Lace, place marker, [k1, p1] twice, knit to end of row. Row 2: Purl to 4 sts before marker, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work Row 2 of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice. Row 3: K1, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work Row 3 of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, [k1, p1] twice, knit to end of row.
Row 4: Purl to 4 sts before marker, [p1,
k1] twice, slip marker, work Row 4 of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice. As you continue to knit, keep a row count and work a buttonhole (as in Row 1) at the beginning of Row 11 ( $13,13,15$ ), Row 23 (23, 25,27 ), Row 33 ( $35,37,39$ ), Row 45 ( 45,49 , 51) and Row 55 ( $57,61,63$ ). Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures $73 / 4$
$\left(8,81 / 2,8^{3} / 4\right)^{\prime \prime}(19.5(20.5,21.5,22) \mathrm{cm})$ from beginning; end with a right side row.

## Shape Raglan Armhole

Row 1 (wrong side): Bind off 2 sts, purl to 4 sts before marker, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work next row of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice-27 (29, 31, 33) sts. Row 2 (decrease row): K1, [p1, k1] twice, slip marker, work next row of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, [k1, p1] twice, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, p2-26 (28, 30, 32) sts.
Row 3: K2, purl to 4 sts before marker, [p1,
k1] twice, slip marker, work next row of Little Arrowhead Lace, slip marker, k1, [p1, k1] twice. Repeat last 2 rows $7(8,9,10)$ more times-19 (20, 21, 22) sts.

## Shape Neck

Remove markers as you work the next row. Row 1 (right side): Bind off $7(8,8,9)$ sts, knit to last $9(10,11,12)$ sts, $[k 1, \mathrm{p} 1]$ twice, k 3 (4, $5,6), \mathrm{p} 2-12(12,13,13)$ sts.
Row 2 (wrong side): K2, p2tog through back loops, p2 (3, 4, 5), [k1, p1] $2(1,1,1)$ time(s), k0 ( $1,1,0$ ), p2tog through back loops-10 $(10,11,11)$ sts.
Row 3: K3 (2, 2, 1), [p1, k1] twice, k1 (2, 3, 4), p2.

## Size 6-12 months only:

Row 4: K2, p2tog through back loops, [p1, k1] twice, p2tog through back loops-8 sts. Row 5: K2, [p1, k1] twice, p2.

## Size 12-24 months only:

Row 4 (wrong side): K2, p2tog through
back loops, p2, k1, p1, p2tog through back loops-8 sts.
Row 5: [k1, p1] twice, k2, p2.

## Size 2-3 years only:

Row 4 (wrong side): K2, p2tog through back loops, p3, k1, p1, p2tog through back loops-9 sts.
Row 5: [K1, p1] twice, k3, p2.

## Size 3-5 years only:

Row 4 (wrong side): K2, p2tog through back loops, p4, k1, p2tog through back loops-9 sts. Row 5: K2, p1, k4, p2.

## All Sizes:

Work even in Stockinette st until armholes measure $4 \frac{1}{4}\left(4 \frac{1}{2} / 2,5,5^{114}\right)$ " $(10.5$ (11.5, 12.5, 13.5) cm ); end with a wrong side row. Bind off.

## LEFT SLEEVE

With smaller needles, cast on $27(29,31,33)$ sts.
Work in Seed st for 8 rows.
Change to larger needles.
Beginning with a right side (knit) row, work in Stockinette st for 2 rows.

Increase Row (right side): K1, M1, knit to last st, M1, k1-29 (31, 33, 35) sts.
Work even in Stockinette st for 9 rows.
Repeat last 10 rows $2(3,4,5)$ more
times-33 $(37,41,45)$ sts.
Work even in Stockinette st until piece
measures $73 / 4(81 / 4,81 / 2,9)$ ) $(19.5(21,21.5,23)$
cm ) from beginning; end with a wrong side row.

## Shape Raglan Edges

Row 1 (right side): Bind off 2 sts, knit to end of row- $31(35,39,43)$ sts.
Row 2: Bind off 2 sts, purl to end of row-29 ( $33,37,41$ ) sts.
Row 3 (decrease row): P2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, p2-27 (31, 35, 39) sts.

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Row 4: K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. Repeat last 2 rows $8(9,10,11)$ more times$11(13,15,17)$ sts; end with a right side row.

## Shape Cap

Row 1 (decrease - wrong side): Bind off 5 ( 6 , $7,8)$ sts, purl to last 2 sts, $k 2-6(7,8,9)$ sts. Row 2 (decrease - right side): P 2 , k2tog, knit to end of row-5 ( $6,7,8$ ) sts.
Bind off.

## RIGHT SLEEVE

Work same as Left Sleeve to Shape Cap; end with a wrong side row-11 $(13,15,17)$ sts.

## Shape Cap

Row 1 (decrease - right side): Bind off 5 (6, 7, 8) sts, knit to last 2 sts, p2-6 (7, 8, 9) sts. Row 3 (decrease - wrong side): K2, p2tog through back loops, purl to end of row-5 (6, 7, 8) sts.
Bind off.

## FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements shown on schematic. Weave in ends. Sew shoulder seams. Sew Left Front and Right Front raglan edges to front raglan edges of Sleeves. Sew Back raglan edges to back raglan edges of Sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew buttons to left front band, opposite the buttonholes on right front.

$\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit next 2 sts together; $\mathrm{p}=$ purl; p2tog = purl next 2 sts together; $\mathrm{st}(\mathrm{s})=$ stitch (es); yo = yarn over; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * $=$ repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
