What you will need:


RED HEART® Super Saver®
Jumbo: 2 skeins 387 Soft Navy A,
1 skein each 381 Light Blue B and
334 Buff C

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6mm [US J-10]

GAUGE: 1 ripple = 3¼" (8.5 cm)
from peak to peak; 7 rows = 5½"
(14 cm) in pattern. CHECK YOUR
GAUGE. Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.

French Country Throw

This crochet ripple throw evokes images of the French countryside and happy picnics in the park. It's perfect for a country chic home or change up the colors for any décor.

Throw measures 45" wide x 55" long (114.5 x 139.5 cm).

Special Stitch

dc2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch or chain, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Notes

1. Throw is made in a ripple pattern which consists of a series of 5-dc "peaks" and 4-dc2tog "valleys". You may need to work several rows before the ripple is clearly visible.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

THROW

With A, ch 127.

Row 1 (wrong side): Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc), dc2tog, 5 dc in next ch, *[dc2tog] 4 times, 5 dc in next ch; repeat from * 12 times, dc2tog, dc in last 2 ch, turn—128 sts.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), [dc2tog] twice, 5 dc in next st, *[dc2tog] 4 times, 5 dc in next st; repeat from * 12 times, [dc2tog] twice, dc in top of beginning ch, turn.

Rows 3–70: Repeat Row 2 sixty-eight times and change color as in the following color sequence: Work 1 row with A, *1 row with B, 2 rows with A, 1 row with B, 3 rows with C, 1 row with A, 2 rows with B, 1 row with A, 3 rows with C, 1 row with B, 2 rows with A, 1 row with B**, 5 rows with A; repeat from * twice ending at **, 3 rows with A. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever
