## All that Chic Throw

Combine all the colors you love for a jazzy throw that has a happy vibe! Motifs are joined as you crochet them so that you don't have to sew them all together at the end.

## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Chic Sheep™:** 1 ball of 5324 Mimosa **A**, 3 balls each of 5622 Dragon Fruit **B**, 5327 Mai Tai **C**, 5641 Sterling **D**, 5673 Fairy Tale **E**, 6 balls of 5640 Platinum **F**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle, 2" (2.5 cm) Pompom maker

**GAUGE:** Motif (corner ch-space to corner ch-space) = 4.75" (12 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## BUY YARN



**RED HEART® Chic Sheep by Marly Bird™**, Art. R170 100% Merino Wool available 3.5 oz (100 g), 200 yd (183 m) balls

**Project measures 54" [137 cm] in width, 60" [152.5 cm] in length.**

### Pattern Notes

Beginning chain 2 does not count as a stitch throughout. Work last round for all motifs in Color **F**.

Make 154 motifs, crochet rounds 1-3 of motif in the following colors:

- Color **A**, 11 motifs
- Color **B**, 26 motifs
- Color **C**, 39 motifs
- Color **D**, 26 motifs
- Color **E**, 39 motifs
- Color **F**, 13 motifs

### Special Stitches

**Ch-3 join:** Ch 1, slip st to adjoining ch-2 space, ch 1

## PATTERN

### Make 1 motif

Join remaining motifs as you crochet using layout as a guide for placement.

Make an adjustable loop,

**Round 1 (RS):** Ch 2, 12 dc in loop, slip st to first dc, pull loop closed. Do not turn- 12 dc.

**Round 2:** Ch 2, 2 dc in each dc around, slip st to first dc. Do not turn.

**Round 3:** Ch 2, \*2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from \* around, slip st to first dc. Fasten off color. Do not turn.

**Round 4:** Ch 2, \*dc in next 5 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next dc; repeat from \* around, slip st to first dc. Fasten off.

### Joining

Repeat directions for motif thru Round 3. On Round 4, substitute ch-3 join for a ch-2 space at adjoining corners.

## EDGING

**Round 1:** Join **F** in any ch-2 space corner with slip st, ch 2, \*(dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, dc in ea dc to next corner; repeat from \* around, slip st to first dc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in all loose ends. Make 40 pompoms in the following colors: (12) Color **B** and **E**, (13) Color **C** and **D** Using photo as a guide, sew pompoms to edge of throw at ch-2 space corners.

## ABBREVIATIONS

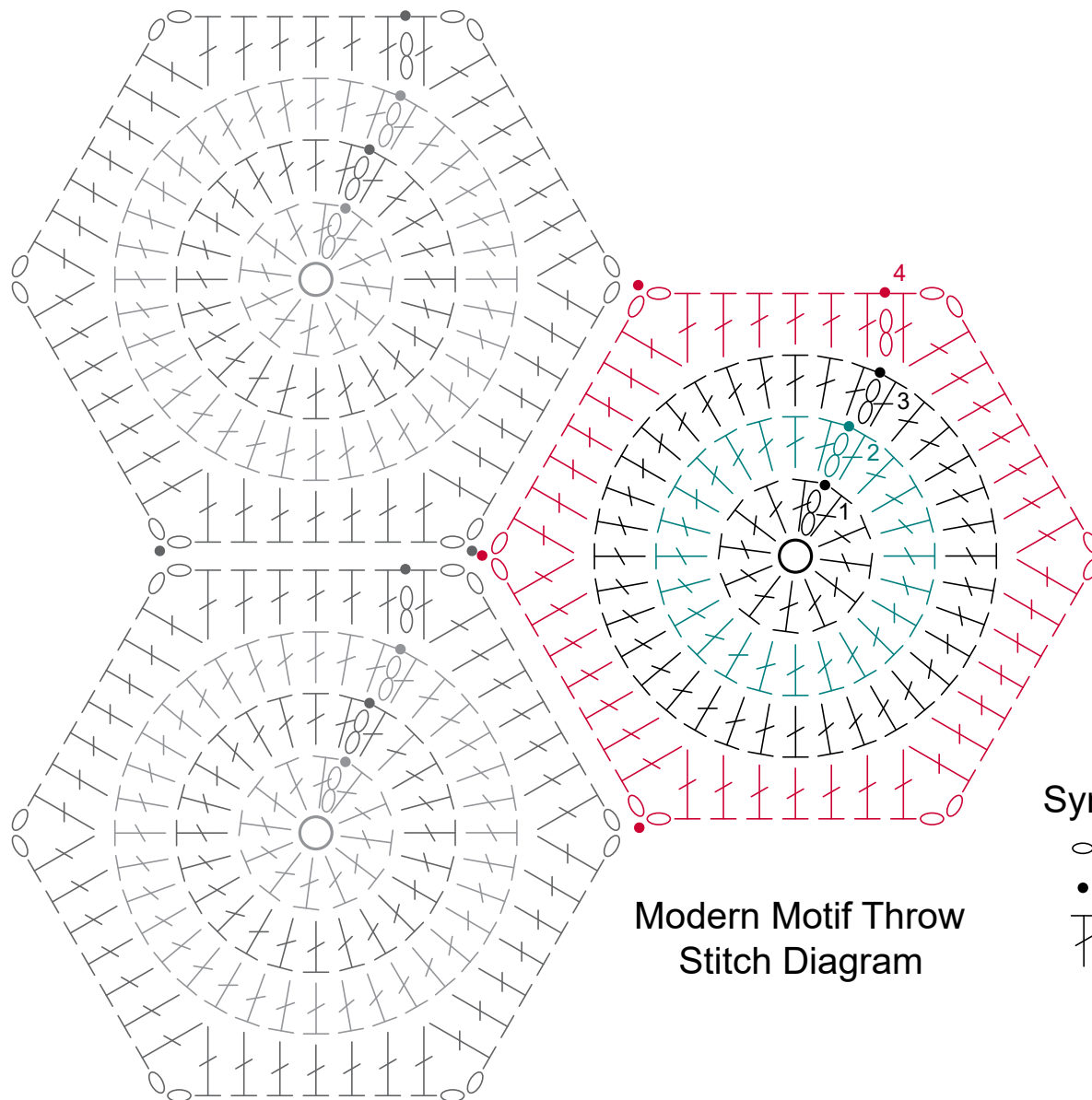
**ch** = chain; **ch-sp** = chain space; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **sl st** = slip stitch; **sc** = single crochet; **dc** = double crochet; **tc** = turning chain; **RS** = right side; **WS** = wrong side; **( )** = work directions in parentheses in same st; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
