



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdc2tog = Yoh and draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remaining(s)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]

L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]

XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]

2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]

4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust measurement

XS/S 40" [101.5 cm]

M 44" [112 cm]

L 48" [122 cm]

XL 53" [134.5 cm]

2/3XL 60" [152.5 cm]

4/5XL 66" [167.5 cm]

MATERIALS

Bernat® Plentiful™ (10.6 oz/300 g; 952 yds/871 m)

Sizes **XS/S** **M** **L** **XL** **2/3XL** **4/5XL**

Wet Stone (19013) **1** **1** **1** **1** **2** **2** **ball(s)**

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 2 stitch markers. Yarn needle.

GAUGE

10 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Ch 2 at beg of rows **does not** count as st.

FRONT

Ch **53 (57-61-69-77-85).

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **51** (55-59-67-75-83) dc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 dc. *1 dcbp around next dc. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 hdc. *1 dcbp around next st 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 3 hdc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for Ridge Pat until work from beg measures 6" [15 cm], ending on 4th row.

Shape sides: Keeping cont of pat, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 2. 2 hdc in first st. 1 hdc in each st to last st. 2 hdc in last st. Turn. **53** (57-61-69-77-85) hdc.

Work 3 rows even in Ridge Pat. Rep last 4 rows twice more. **57** (61-65-73-81-89) sts.

Next row: (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 hdc. *1 dcbp around next st 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 3 hdc. Rep from * to last 3 sts. 1 dcbp around next st 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of last 2 hdc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for Ridge Pat until work from beg measures 12½" [32 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Shape Sleeves: 1st row: (RS). Ch **8** (8-8-8-7-5). Join ch and pat across **57** (61-65-73-81-89) sts. Ch **10** (10-10-10-9-7). Turn. PM at beg of row.

2nd row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each of next **7** (7-7-7-6-4) ch. Pat across **57** (61-65-73-81-89) sts. 1 hdc in each of last **8** (8-8-8-7-5) ch. Turn. **73** (77-81-89-95-99) sts.**

Cont in Ridge Pat until work from marked row measures **5½** (6-6½-6½-7-7)" [**14** (15-16.5-16.5-18-18) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next **28** (29-31-34-36-38) sts. Hdc2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row.

3rd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. **26** (27-29-32-34-36) sts.

Cont even in Ridge Pat until work from marked row measures **8½** (9-9½-9½-10-10)" [**21.5** (23-24-24-25.5-25.5) cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

With RS facing, skip next **13** (15-15-17-19-19) sts. Join yarn with sl st to next st and proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.

3rd row: As 1st row. **26** (27-29-32-34-36) sts.

Cont even in Ridge Pat until work from marked row measures **8½** (9-9½-9½-10-10)" [**21.5** (23-24-24-25.5-25.5) cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

BACK

Work from ** to ** as given for Front.

Cont in Ridge Pat until work from marked row measures **7½** (8-8½-8½-9-9)" [**19** (20.5-21.5-21.5-23-23) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next **26** (27-29-32-34-36) sts. Hdc2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Fasten off.

With RS facing, skip next **17** (19-19-21-23-23) sts. Join yarn with sl st to next st and proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neck edging: 1st rnd: (RS). Join yarn with sl st at left shoulder. Ch 1. Work 10 sc down left front neck edge. 1 sc in each of next **13** (**15-15-17-19-19**) sts. Work 10 sc up right front neck edge. Work 3 sc down right back neck edge. 1 sc in each of next **17** (**19-19-21-23-23**) sts. Work 3 sc up left back neck edge. Join with sl st to first sc. **56** (**60-60-64-68-68**) sc.

2nd and 3rd rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Sleeve edging: 1st rnd: (RS). Join yarn with sl st at bottom sleeve seam. Ch 1. Work **42** (**46-48-48-50-50**) sc evenly around. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd and 3rd rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
