



MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Vintage White (10006)

5 balls

Dark Gray (10044)

4 balls

Size U.S. P (11.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Hdc = Half double crochet

Rep = Repeat

Sc = Single crochet

Splhdc = Split half double crochet: work hdc between 'legs' of st (splitting st) instead of through top loops

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

Surface Sl st = Holding working yarn at back of work, insert hook in first ch-1 sp. Draw up a loop. Insert hook into next ch-1 sp. Yoh and pull loop through to front of work and onto hook. Draw loop through loop on hook.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52" x 64" [132 cm x 162.5 cm]

GAUGE

6 sc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Blanket: With A, ch 105.

1st row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 hdc in next ch. Rep from * to end of chain. (52 hdc and 51 ch-1 sps). Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. *1 splhdc in next st. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last st. 1 splhdc in last st. Turn.

Rep last row 4 times more. Break A. With B, rep 2nd row 6 times. Break B.

With A, rep 2nd row 6 times. Break A.

Rep last 12 rows for Stripe Pat 8 times more. (114 rows in total have been worked).

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Vertical Surface Sl St Rows: Beg with A, working from bottom to top edge, surface sl st in each ch-1 sp of every row. Fasten off. Create vertical stripes by alternating 3 sl st rows with A and 3 sl st rows with B across width of Blanket, as shown in photo.
