



SIZES

To fit bust measurement

Extra-Small/Small/Medium	28-38" [71-96.5 cm]
Large/XL/2XL	40-48" [101.5-122 cm]
3/4/5 X-Large	54-62" [137-157.5 cm]

MATERIALS

Bernat® Roving™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Sizes	XS/S/M	L/XL/2XL	3/4/5 X-L	
Quartz Pink (00717)	8	10	12	balls

Sizes U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) and U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

GAUGES

9 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller hook.

8 sc and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

FRONT

With smaller hook, ch **36** (**40-44**).
(See diagram on page 3).



1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **35 (39-43)** sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row 5 times more.

Next row: (WS). Ch 1. *Sc2togbl over first 2 sts. 1 scbl in each of next **5 (6-7)** scbl. Rep from * to last 7 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem 7 sts unworked. Place marker on last st of 7 unworked sts. **24 (28-32)** sts.

Change to larger hook.

Next row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. 1 dc in next st. *1 sc in next st. 1 dc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. 1 dc in next sc. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures approx **53 (59-63)**" [**134.5 (150-160)** cm], ending on a RS row.

Change to smaller hook.

Next row: (WS). Ch 1. 2 scbl in first st. 1 scbl in each of next **5 (6-7)** sts. *2 scbl in next st. 1 scbl in each of next **5 (6-7)** sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. **28 (32-36)** sts.

2nd row: (RS). Ch 8. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 6 ch. 1 scbl in each st to end of row.

Turn. **35 (39-43)** sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row 5 times more.

Fasten off.

COLLAR

With RS facing and smaller hook, join yarn with sl st to marked first scbl of 7 unworked sts of Front.

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. 7 sts. Turn.

Rep last row **7 (11-13)** times more.

Inc Shawl Collar: 1st row (inc row): (RS). Ch 1. 2 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each scbl to end of row. Turn.

2nd to 4th rows: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each scbl to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 4 rows 8 times more. 16 sts.

Next row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each scbl to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from marked st measures approx **34 (39½-42)**" [**86.5 (100.5-106.5)** cm], ending on a WS row.

Dec Shawl Collar: 1st row (dec row): (RS). Ch 1. Sc2togbl. 1 scbl in each scbl to end of row. Turn.


2nd to 4th rows: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each scbl to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 4 rows 8 times more. 7 sts.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each scbl to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row **7 (11-13)** times more. Fasten off.

Sew last row of Collar to bottom of extended scbl section at top of Front using whipstitch. Sew straight edge of Collar to side edge of Front using whipstitch.



BACK

With smaller hook, ch **69 (77-85)**.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **68 (76-84)** sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each scbl to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row 5 times more.

Next row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 2 scbl. *Sc2togbl. 1 scbl in each of next **6 (7-8)** scbl. Rep from * to last 2 scbl. 1 scbl in each of last 2 scbl. **60 (68-74)** sts.

Change to larger hook.

Next row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. 1 dc in next st. *1 sc in next st. 1 dc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. 1 dc in next sc. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures approx **13 (14-14)**" [**33 (35.5-35.5)** cm], ending on a WS row.


Fasten off.

FINISHING

Center top edge of Back along bottom edge of Front. Sew in place using whipstitch. Sew side of Front ribbing to side of Back ribbing to form armhole. Rep on opposite side. (See Diagram on page 3).

Armhole edging

With RS facing and smaller hook, join yarn with sl st to armhole at bottom seam. Ch 1. Work sc evenly around armhole opening. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
