MATERIALS

Bernat[®] **Softee**[®] **Baby**[™] (5 oz/140 g; 362 yds/331 m)

Main Color (MC) Flannel (30010) 3 balls Contrast A Soft Red (30424) 1 ball 1 ball Contrast B Mint (02004) Contrast C Soft Peach (30410) 1 ball Contrast D Aqua (30201) 1 ball

Size U.S. G/7 (4.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Tapestry needle.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Bobble = Yoh. Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop. Yoh and pull through 2 loops. (Yoh. Insert hook in same space and pull up a loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops) 5 times. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook. Use fingers to push bobble tog and shape it.

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front

of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Hbhdc = Herringbone half double crochet—Yoh and insert hook into designated stitch. Draw through stitch and first loop on hook. Yoh and draw through both remaining loops.

Hdc = Half double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

SI st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook



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MEASUREMENTS

Approx 29" x 34" [73.5 x86.5 cm].

GAUGE

16 sts and 14 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note:

- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.
- Carry color when not in use loosely across top of previous row and work sts around it to avoid stranding.

With MC, ch 111. (Pattern is worked over a multiple of 10 ch + 1).

1st row: 1 hbhdc in 3rd chain from hook. 1 hbhdc in each ch to end of chain, 109 hbhdc.

2nd to 7th rows: With MC, ch 2. 1 hbhdc in each st to end of row. Turn..

8th row: With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. With A, bobble in next st. *With MC, one sc in each of next 9 sts. With A, bobble in next st. Rep from * to last 4 sts. With MC, 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. Break A. Turn.

9th to 15th rows: With MC, ch 2. Border 1 hbhdc in each st to end of row. Join MC with a sl st to any corner. Turn.

16th row: With MC, ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 9 sts. With B, bobble in next st. Rep from * to last 9 sts. 1 sc in each of last 9 sts. Break B. Turn.

17th to 23rd rows: As 9th to 15th rows.

24th row: With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. With C, bobble in next st. *With MC, one sc in each of * around. next 9 sts. With C, bobble in next st. **Note:** When you work corners, Turn.

25th to 31st rows: As 9th to 15th rows.

32nd row: With MC, ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 9 sts. With D, bobble in next st. Rep from * to last 9 sts. 1 sc in each of last 9 sts. Break D. Turn. 33rd to 39th rows: As 9th to 15th

Rep rows 8th to 39th rows twice more. Fasten off.

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 3. Work 1 rnd of dc evenly around blanket, working 3 dc in each corner. Join with sl st to first dc.

Note: You will work 1 dc per row along the left and right sides of Blanket.

2nd rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from

Rep from * to last 4 sts. With MC, you will maintain cont of (1 dcfp. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. Break C. 1 dcbp) st pat while working 3 sts around corner sts. You will work either (1 dcfp. 1 dcbp. 1 dcfp) or (1 dcbp 1 dcfp, 1 dcbp) around corner sts to maintain cont of pat.

> Weave inends with a tapestry needle..
