

## BERNAT® BIG WAVES THROW | KNIT



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 40" x 62" [101.5 x 157.5 cm].

### GAUGE

5 sts and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm]  
in stocking st.

### MATERIALS

**Bernat® Mega Bulky™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 64 yds/58 m)

<b>Contrast A</b> Aran (88008)	<b>4</b>	<b>balls</b>
<b>Contrast B</b> New Gold (88609)	<b>2</b>	<b>balls</b>
<b>Contrast C</b> Black (88040)	<b>2</b>	<b>balls</b>
<b>Contrast D</b> Purple (88334)	<b>2</b>	<b>balls</b>
<b>Contrast E</b> Radiant Orchid (88314)	<b>2</b>	<b>balls</b>

Size U.S. 35 (19 mm) circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long  
or size needed to obtain gauge.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**Approx** = Approximately

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**M1** = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop

**Pat** = Pattern

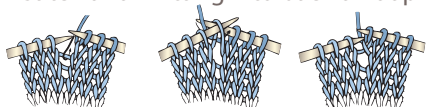
**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side



### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Stripe Pat

**With A:** 4 rows.

**With B:** 6 rows.

**With C:** 6 rows.

**With D:** 6 rows.

**With E:** 6 rows.

**With A:** 4 rows.

These 32 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 54 sts. **Do not** join. *Working back and forth across needle in rows*, proceed as follows:

Knit 3 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS.

Beg Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). K3. \*(ssk) twice. (K1. M1) 4 times. (K2tog) twice. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. K3.

**2nd row:** K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3.

**3rd row:** Knit.

**4th row:** K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3.

Last 4 rows form Ripple Pat. First 4 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in pat as established until 32 rows of Stripe Pat have been completed 3 times.

With A, knit 3 rows.

Cast off (WS).
