



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Hdcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

**Hdcfp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

**Inc'd** = Increase(d)

**Pat** = Pattern

**PM** = Place marker

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sc2togtbl** = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc through back loops. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

**Sc3tog** = Draw up a loop in each of next 3 sc. Yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook

**Scbl** = Single crochet in back loop only

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

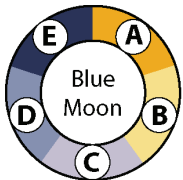
**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MATERIALS

Caron® Big Donut™ O'Go™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 502 yds/459 m)

Blue Moon (29005)

1 O'Go



Sizes U.S. H/8 (5 mm) and U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 60" [152.5 cm] wide x 16" [40.5 cm] deep.

## GAUGES

15 sts and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller hook in Sc/Ch-1 Pat.

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section (Contrast A, B, C, D and E). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D and E.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- **Do not** cut yarn. Carry color not in use along side edge of work.

### Stripe Pat A

Work 2 rows A.

Work 2 rows B.

These 4 rows form Stripe Pat A.

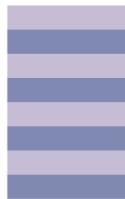


### Stripe Pat B

Work 2 rows C.

Work 2 rows D.

These 4 rows form Stripe Pat B.



### Stripe Pat C

E – 4 rows, A– 2 rows, E– 4 rows,

B– 2 rows, E– 4 rows, C– 2 rows,

E– 4 rows, D– 2 rows, E– 4 rows,

C– 2 rows, E– 4 rows, B– 2 rows.

These 36 rows form Stripe Pat C.



## RIGHT TRIANGLE

See Triangle Diagram on page 3.

Proceed in Stripe Pat A as follows:  
With smaller hook and A, ch 6.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch) twice. Turn. 5 sts (sc and ch-1).

**2nd row:** Ch 6. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch) twice. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 10 sts (sc and ch-1). Join B.

**3rd row:** With B, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. (Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp) 4 times. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 10 sts (sc and ch-1).

**4th row:** Ch 6. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (1 sc in next ch. Ch 1. Skip next ch) twice. 1 sc in next sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 15 sts (sc and ch-1). Join A.

4 rows of Stripe Pat A are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat A, proceed as follows:

**5th row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

**6th row:** Ch 6. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch) twice. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. (5 sts inc'd). Join B.

**7th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

**8th row:** Ch 6. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (1 sc in next ch. Ch 1. Skip next ch) twice. 1 sc in next sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. (5 sts inc'd).

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat A, rep last 4 rows until work from beg across shorter side measures 11" [28 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

### LEFT TRIANGLE

Work as given for Right Triangle, substituting Stripe Pat B for Stripe Pat A.

### CENTER PIECE

Proceed in Stripe Pat C as follows:

**Joining row:** (RS). With larger hook, join E with sl st at corner of Left Triangle. Ch 1. Work 38 sc evenly across side edge of Left Triangle. Work 39 sc evenly across side edge of Right Triangle. Turn. 77 sc. See Assembly Diagram on page 3.

First row of Stripe Pat C is complete.

Cont in Stripe Pat C as follows:

**1st row:** Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 36 sc. Sc2togtbl. 1 hdcbp around each of next 3 sts. PM on last st just made. Sc2togtbl. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn. 75 sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to 2 sts before marked st. Sc2togtbl. 1 hdcfp around each of next 3 sts. PM on last st just made. Sc2togtbl. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 73 sts.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to 2 sts before marked st. Sc2togtbl. 1 hdcfp around each of next 3 sts. PM on last st just made. Sc2togtbl. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 71 sts.

First 4 rows of Stripe Pat C are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat C, rep last 2 rows until 5 sts rem.

**Next row:** Ch 1. Sc2togtbl. 1 hdcfp. Sc2togtbl. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 1. Sc3tog. Fasten off.
