



## Lace Pendant Necklace

*Here's a quick-to-crochet pendant that is attached to a simple chain. Create this small project as a gift (or for yourself) in elegant, silky Bamboo crochet thread and you'll be hooked and want to use it for your other thread crochet projects.*

**Pendant measures 3" wide at widest point (blocked)**

**AUNT LYDIA'S® "Bamboo Crochet Thread", size 10:**  
1 ball 275 Coral.

**Crochet Hook:** 2.25mm [US B-1]  
18" chain (in two sections)  
Jump rings  
Clasp  
Pliers to attach jump rings  
Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Motif = 3" across from point to opposite point.  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

### Special Abbreviations:

**Ch-4 Picot** = Ch 4, slip st in 4th ch from hook.

**Ch-5 Picot** = Ch 5, slip st in 5th ch from hook.

**Picot Corner** = Sc in next ch-5 loop, ch-4 picot, slip st in last sc made, ch-5 picot, slip st in last sc made, ch-4 picot, slip st in last sc made.

### MOTIF

Ch 6; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 1, 8 sc in ring; join with a slip st in first sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*ch 8, sc in next sc; repeat from \* 7 times, ch 4, tr in first sc instead of last ch-7 space.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, sc in space made by tr, \*ch 4, (sc, ch 5, sc) in next ch-7 space\*\*, ch 4, sc in next ch-8 space; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*, ch 1, dc in first sc instead of last ch-4 space.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, sc in space made by dc, ch 5, \*sc in next ch-4 space, ch 2, ch-4 picot, ch 2, picot corner in next ch-5 space, ch 2, ch-4 picot, ch 2, sc in next ch-4 space\*\*, ch 5; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to final measurements. Following manufacturer's instructions, attach jump rings to 2 ch-4 picots on either side of any picot corner as shown. Attach jump rings to chain. Attach clasp to back of chain.

**AUNT LYDIA'S® "Bamboo Crochet Thread, 100% Viscose from Bamboo" Size 10, Art. 148** available in 300 yd (276 m) balls.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **slip st** = slip stitch; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble crochet; **[]** = work directions given in brackets the number of times specified; \* **or** \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
