To fit Waist Child

3-5 yrs	22" [56 cm]
6-8 yrs	24" [61 cm]
9-12 yrs	26" [66 cm]

Yarn Length Child

3-5 yrs	38" [96.5 cm]
6-8 yrs	40" [101.5 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: When changing colors tie new color to end of previous color using magic knot technique (See Graphic on Page 2).

1. Cut one 36" [91.5 cm] length of B. Cut 6 lengths of A, using Size Guide for Yarn Length.



2. Fasten all seven lengths of yarn together by tying a knot on one end, leaving 8" [20.5 cm] tails.



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

VERSION I

Contrast A Turqua (512)	1 ball or 11 yds/10 m
Contrast B Macaw (3944)	1 ball or 10 yds/9 m

VERSION II

Contrast A Pretty'n Pink (722)	1 ball or 11 yds/10 m
Contrast B Day Glow (3934)	1 ball or 10 yds/9 m

6 drinking straws ¼" [0.6 cm] diameter. Scissors.

3. Line up 6 straws and insert one length of A through each straw.



4. With long length of B, begin to weave across straws, alternating yarn over and under each straw.
5. When you reach the edge of straws, begin working in opposite direction. Continue weaving back and forth.



6. After you have completed a few rows of weaving, push yarn up toward top of straws.
7. When you get to end of B, tie on a 36" [91.4 cm] length of A using magic knot.



8. Continue to weave A over and under straws.






9. Continue weaving, alternating B and A.
10. When weaving has reached end of straws, pull straws away from knotted end, leaving some weaving on straws.
11. Continue weaving until desired length is reached. Slide weaving off straws completely.
12. Tie all strands together to secure, leaving 8" [20.5 cm] tails

MAGIC KNOT

Step 1: Align working yarn and new yarn to run parallel to one another. Tie knot around loose ends with both yarns.

Step 2: Pull each knot tight around the opposite yarn.

Step 3: Pull long ends of both yarns to move knots together. Cut short ends as close to the knots as possible.
