What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 3 skeins
1955 Parade

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle, Susan Bates® Easy
Wrap Pom Pon Maker or 4"
(10 cm) piece of heavy cardboard

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" (10 cm); 9
rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE. Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.**

7oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m) and

Pom-pom Parade Scarf

*Here's the perfect scarf for beginners to crochet!
Working your half double crochets into the back
loops gives you a nice stretchy scarf and the
pom-poms give it a fun finish.*

Scarf measures 8" x 64" (20.5 x 162.5 cm).

SCARF

Ch 157.

Row 1: Working in back bars, slip st in 2nd
ch from hook and in next 2 ch, hdc in each
ch across to last 3 ch, slip st in last 3 ch,
turn—6 slip sts and 150 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 1, slip st in first 3 slip sts, hdc in
back loop of each hdc, slip st in last 3 slip
sts, turn.

Row 3–18: Repeat Row 2.
Fasten off.

Pom-pom (make 2)

Following Pom Pon Maker directions, make
4" (10 cm) pom-pom or make pom-pom as
follows: Wrap yarn around 4" (10 cm)
piece of heavy cardboard (the more wraps,
the fuller the pom-pom). Gently remove
wraps from cardboard. Cut a 12" (30.5 cm)
length of yarn and tie it tightly around
center of wraps. Do not cut the ends of
this center tie. Cut ends of wraps. Fluff
and trim pom-pom. Use ends of center
tie to tie pom-pom to end of scarf.
Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain(s); **hdc** = half double
crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).



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
