



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

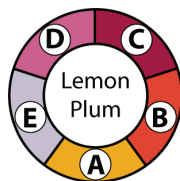

MATERIALS

Caron® Big Donut™ O'Go™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 502 yds/459 m)

Main Color (MC) Vanilla Glaze (29015) **2 O'Gos**
 Lemon Plum (29002) **2 O'Gos**



Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
 Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 16" [40.5 cm] wide x 69" [179 cm] long.

GAUGES

16 sts and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Hdc/Ch-1 Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.

- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D, E). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D, E.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- **Do not** cut yarn. Carry color not in use along side edge of work.

Stripe Pat I

Work 6 rows each color in the following sequence: A, B, C, D, E. These 30 rows form Stripe Pat I.

Stripe Pat II

Work 8 rows with A.
Work 8 rows with B.
Work 4 rows with C.
These 20 rows form Stripe Pat II.

Stripe Pat III

Work 8 rows with E.
Work 8 rows with D.
Work 4 rows with C.
These 20 rows form Stripe Pat II

Left Side of Shawl

Center Section: With MC, ch 4.

1st row: (RS). (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in 4th ch from hook. Turn. 6 dc.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in first dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. Ch 1. (1 hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc.) in next ch-2 sp. PM on ch-2 sp for center. Ch 1. 1 hdc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. (1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc) in last dc. Turn. 7 sts (hdc and ch-1 sp) at each side of center ch-2 sp.

3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. (Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp) twice. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. (1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp) twice. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in 3rd ch of turning ch. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 2nd ch of turning ch. Turn. 11 sts (hdc and ch-1 sp) at each side of center ch-2 sp.

4th row: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp.* Rep from * to * to last hdc before ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. (1 hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from * to * to last hdc and turning ch-3. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in 3rd ch of turning ch. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 2nd ch of turning ch. Turn. 13 sts (hdc and ch-1 sp) at each side of center ch-2 sp.

5th row: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp.* Rep from * to * to last hdc before ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. (1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc) all in next ch-2 sp. Rep from * to * to last hdc and turning ch-3. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in 3rd ch of turning ch. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 2nd ch of turning ch. Turn. 17 sts (hdc and ch-1 sp) at each side of center ch-2 sp.

Rep last 2 rows 7 times more, then 4th row once. 61 sts (hdc and ch-1 sp) at each side of center ch-2 sp, ending on a WS row. Join A. Break MC.

Section 1

Proceed in Stripe Pat I as follows:
1st row: (RS). With A, ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last hdc before ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in ch-2 sp. 63 sts (hdc and ch-1 sps). **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 2 (counts as st). *1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. Rep from * to last turning ch-3. 1 hdc in 3rd ch of turning ch. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 2nd ch of turning ch. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.

First 3 rows of Stripe Pat I are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat I, rep last 2 rows until all 30 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. 122 sts. Join MC. Break E.

Section 2

1st row: (RS). With MC, ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Sl st in each of first 2 hdc. Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last turning ch-3. 1 hdc in 3rd ch of turning ch. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 2nd ch of turning ch. **Turn.**

Rep last 2 rows until work from foundation ch-2 measures approx 29" [73.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape sides as follows: 1st row: (RS). Sl st in first hdc, ch-1 sp and next hdc. Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Sl st in each of first 2 hdc. Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

Rep last row until 2 hdc rem. Fasten off.

Section 3

Following Diagram, with RS facing, skip post of first row at bottom corner of work of Section 1. Join A with sl st to post of next row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat II as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 2 (counts as hdc). Work (1 hdc. Ch 1) 29 times across side edge of Section 1. 1 hdc in corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last turning ch-3. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 3rd ch of turning ch. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 2nd ch of turning ch. **Turn.** 122 sts (hdc and ch-1 sps).

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

3rd row: Sl st in first hdc, ch-1 sp and next hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last turning ch-3. 1 hdc in 3rd ch of turning ch. Ch 1. 1 hdc in 2nd ch of turning ch. **Turn.**

First 3 rows of Stripe Pat II are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat II, rep last 2 rows until all 20 rows of Stripe Pat II are complete. Fasten off.

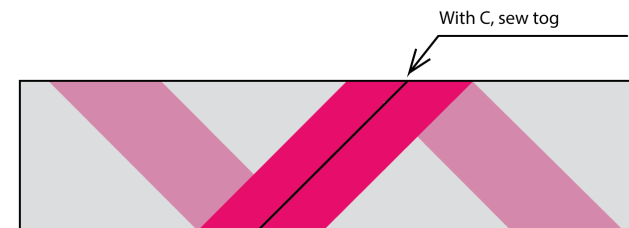
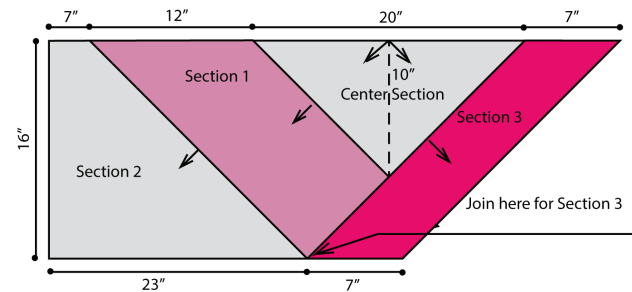
Right Side of Shawl

Work as given for Left Side of Shawl, substituting Stripe Pat III for Stripe Pat II and noting work reverses - RS will become WS and WS will become RS.

FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Flip Right Side of Shawl up-side down and with C, sew both Sides across Section 3.
