What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver Ombre™: 1 skein 3967 Sea Coral

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 5 pattern repeats = 6" (15 cm) (one pattern repeat consists of one shell and one single crochet); 7 rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Ombre™, Art. E305 available in 10 oz, (283 g), 482 yd (440 m) skeins

Sweet Shells Twisted Cowl

You only need one skein to crochet this cowl with a twist that encourages natural draping. You will love the gradient color effect that goes from light to dark and light again while you just keep crocheting!

SHOP KIT

Cowl measures 11" long x 34" circumference (28 x 86.5 cm), including edging.

Special Stitches

dc2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

shell = Ch 3, 4 dc in indicated stitch.

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

Notes

1. Cowl is worked back and forth in rows, then twisted and short ends are seamed together.
2. Edging is made in a single round that works in both ends of each row around.

COWL

Ch 30.

Row 1 (right side): (Sc, shell) in 2nd ch from hook, *skip next 3 ch, (sc, shell) in next ch; repeat from * 5 times, skip next 3 ch, sc in last ch, turn—7 shells.

Row 2: Ch 3, (skip first dc, dc2tog in next 2 dc, skip last dc, ch 3, sc in top of beginning ch-3) of each shell across, turn—7 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, (sc, shell) in each sc across to beginning ch, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—7 shells.

Rows 4–59: Repeat last 2 rows 28 times.

Row 60: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off leaving an 18" (45.5 cm) tail for sewing. Twist 1 short end of piece once and seam short ends together to form tube with single twist.

Edging

Round 1: Working in ends of rows, join with sc in first row nearest seam, shell in same row, *skip next row, (sc, shell) in next row; repeat from * around to last row, skip last row; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = ch(s); **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
