## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Classic™:** 6 skeins 584 Lavender A, 4 skeins 579 Light Lavender B, 3 skeins 412 Silver C, and 2 skeins 401 Nickel D

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks:** 5.5mm [US I-9] and 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 1 square = 10" (25.5 cm); 7 sts = 2½" (6.5 cm); Rows 1–7 of corner #1 = 2" (5 cm) in single crochet with larger hook. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Round You Go Throw

*This interesting layout takes a few twists and turns that may look mind boggling, but it is crocheted with just one square pattern in two color combinations. Do it in soft shades as shown, or create your own original with your own color palette.*

Throw measures 54" wide x 44" long (137 x 112 cm).

## Special Stitches

**sc2tog** = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**sm shell** (small shell) = 3 dc in indicated stitch.

**lg shell** (large shell) = 5 dc in indicated stitch.

## Special Technique

**Join with sc** = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

## Notes

1. Throw is made from 20 squares made in 2 color combinations. Each square has 3 sections: a fan made with a smaller hook and 2 corners made with a larger hook.
2. Squares are sewn together as shown in assembly diagram. Border is worked in joined rounds with right side facing at all times.

## THROW

### Squares (make 20)

Square 1 – make 11 with A, B, C

Square 2 – make 9 with C, A, B

### First Corner

Leaving a 20" (51 cm) tail, with larger hook and first color, ch 17 loosely.

**Row 1 (right side):** Working in back bars only, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—16 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each remaining sc, turn—15 sc.

**Rows 4 and 5:** Repeat Row 2 twice.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn—14 sc.

**Rows 7 and 8:** Repeat Row 2 twice.

**Row 9:** Repeat Row 3—13 sc.

**Rows 10–13:** Repeat Rows 2 and 3 twice—11 sc.

**Rows 14–17:** Repeat Rows 6 and 3 twice—7 sc.

**Row 18:** Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, slip st in next sc; leave remaining sc unworked—6 sts. Fasten off.

## Fan

**Row 1 (right side):** Leaving a 20" (51 cm) tail, with right side facing and smaller hook, join 2nd color with sc in first ch at end of Row 1; working across ends of rows, sc in same row as join and in each row to Row 17; sc in end of row and first sc of Row 17; working in last row, sc in slip st and in last 4 sc, turn—24 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, \*sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc\*; repeat from \* to \* once, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* to \* twice, turn—30 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, skip next 2 sc, sm shell in next sc, skip next sc, sc in next sc, \*skip next sc, shell in next sc, sc in next sc\*; repeat from \* to \* twice, sm shell in next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* to \* 3 times, sm shell in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in last sc, turn—9 sm shells and 10 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in first sc, sc in center dc of first shell, \*sm shell in next sc, sc in center dc of next shell; repeat from \* across to last sc, 2 dc in last sc, turn—8 sm shells, 4 dc, and 9 sc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, skip next dc, sm shell in first sc, \*sc in center dc of next shell, sm shell in next sc; repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, skip next dc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—9 sm shells and 10 sc.

**Row 6:** Repeat Row 4.

**SHOP KIT**



**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, skip next dc, lg shell in first sc, \*sc in center dc of next shell, lg shell in next sc; repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, skip next dc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—9 lg shells and 10 sc.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, dc in first sc, sc in center dc of first shell, \*lg shell in next sc, sc in center dc of next shell; repeat from \* across to last sc, 2 dc in last sc, turn—8 lg shells, 4 dc, and 9 sc.

**Row 9:** Repeat Row 7.

**Row 10:** Repeat Row 8.

**Row 11:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, hdc in next dc, dc in next sc, \*hdc in next dc, sc in next 3 dc, hdc in next dc, dc in next sc; repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, hdc in next dc, sc in top of beginning ch—53 sts. Fasten off, leaving a 20" (51 cm) tail.

### Second Corner

**Row 1 (right side):** With right side of fan facing and larger hook, join 3rd color with sc in 9th st, sc in next 7 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, sc in next 8 sts; leave last 8 sts unworked, turn—39 sts.

**Row 2:** Skip first st, slip st in next 3 sc, sc in next 31 sts; leave remaining sts unworked, turn—31 sc.

**Row 3:** Skip first sc, slip st in next 2 sc, sc in next 25 sc; leave remaining sts unworked, turn—25 sc.

**Rows 4–7:** Skip first sc, slip st in next sc, sc in each sc to last 2 sc; leave last 2 sc unworked, turn—9 sc.

**Row 8:** Skip first sc, sc in next 7 sc; leave last sc unworked, turn—7 sc.

**Row 9:** Skip first sc, sc in next sc, hdc in next sc, 3 dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, sc in next sc; leave last sc unworked—7 sts. Fasten off.

### Edging

Note Work loosely across 2 sides of square.

**Row 1:** Holding with right side of Row 11 of fan facing, with larger hook, join 3rd color with slip st in first st; working across first side, slip st in next 6 sts; working in rows of Second Corner, slip st in first 4 sc of first row, ch 1, slip st in first 2 sc of next row, ch 1, slip st in first 2 slip sts of next row, ch 1, skip next row, slip st in first slip st and in next 2 sc of next row, ch 1, slip st in first sc of next row, slip st in first slip st and in next sc of next row, slip st in end of next row; working in last row, slip st in first 3 sts, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next st (corner made), slip st in last 3 sts; working across 2nd side of square, ch 1, slip st in last 2 sc of next row, [ch 1, skip next row, slip st in last 2 sc and last slip st of next row] twice, ch 1, skip next row, slip st in last 3 sc and in last 3 slip sts of next row, ch 1, slip st in last slip st of next row, slip st in last 7 sts of Row 11 of fan—2 sc, 49 slip sts, 9 ch-1 spaces, and 1 ch-2 space. Fasten off.

### ASSEMBLY

With right sides facing, arrange squares as shown in the assembly diagram. With wrong sides held together, whipstitch squares together with ending tails, working in inside loops (back loop of front side and front loop of back side) of single crochet and slip stitches.

### Border

**Round 1:** With right side facing and larger hook, join **D** with sc in any corner ch-2 space, (ch 2, sc) in same space (corner made); working sc in each st, ch, or end of row, [evenly space 30 sc across first square, sc in next seam between squares, \*evenly space 31 sc across next square, sc in next seam between squares; repeat from \* to last square,

evenly space 30 sc across last square to next corner ch-2 space\*\*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 space (corner made)] 4 times ending at \*\*; join with slip st in first sc—127 sc on each short edge, 159 sc on each long edge, and 4 corner ch-2 spaces.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, (sc, ch 2, sc) in first ch-2 space, \*sc in each sc to next ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 space; repeat from \* twice, sc in each remaining sc; join with slip st in first sc—129 sc on each short edge, 161 sc on each long edge, and 4 ch-2 spaces.

**Round 3:** Ch 3, dc in next sc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch-2 space, \*dc in each sc to next ch-2 space, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 space; repeat from \* twice, dc in each remaining sc; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—133 dc on each short edge, 165 dc on each long edge, and 4 ch-2 spaces.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, sc in same st as join, [\*ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc; repeat from \* to next ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 space] 4 times, \*\*ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc; repeat from \*\* to last dc, ch 1, skip last dc; join with slip st to first sc—68 sc and 67 ch-1 spaces on each short edge, 84 sc and 83 ch-1 spaces on each long edge, and 4 ch-2 spaces.

**Round 5:** Slip st in first ch-1 space, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same ch-1 space; [(sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-1 space to next ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc, ch 3, sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 space] 4 times, (sc, ch 2, sc) in each remaining ch-1 space; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block lightly as needed.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
