## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Cutie Pie™:** 1 (2, 2, 2) balls 541 Jelly

**Susan Bates® Crochet**

**Hook:** 4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 13 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 9 rows = 6" [15 cm] in openwork strip pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Little Fashion Poncho

*Young girls will love feeling fashionable in this comfortable to wear poncho. Choose her favorite color of this soft chenille yarn and crochet it in little time.*

SHOP KIT

**Directions are for size 2 years; changes for sizes 4, 6 and 8 years are in parentheses.**

**Width:** 20 (21, 23, 24)" [51 (53.5, 58.5, 61) cm]

**Length:** 12 (13, 14½, 16)" [30.5 (33, 37, 40.5) cm]

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Bpdc:** (back post double crochet) Yo, insert hook from back to front then to back, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice. Skip st in front of the Bpdc.

**Fpdc:** (front post double crochet) Yo, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice. Skip st behind the Fpdc.

## PONCHO

### BACK

Ch 66 (71, 76, 81).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 65 (70, 75, 80) sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, dc in next sc, [ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next 4 sc] across to last 3 sc, ch 1, skip next sc, dc in last 2 sc – 65 (70, 75, 80) sts.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next 4 dc] across to last 3 sts, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in last 2 dc – 65 (70, 75, 80) sts. Repeat Row 3 for 16 (18, 20, 22) more rows and piece measures 12 (13, 14½, 16)" [30.5 (33, 37, 40.5) cm] from beginning. Fasten off.

## Bottom Edging

**Row 1:** With right side facing and working along opposite edge of foundation ch, join yarn at right side with a slip st, ch 3, dc in each ch across lower edge – 65 (70, 75, 80) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first post st), turn, [Bpdc in next dc, Fpdc in next dc] across to last 0 (1, 0, 1) st, Bpdc in last 0 (1, 0, 1) st. Fasten off.

## FRONT

Work same as for Back until 16 (18, 20, 22) rows have been worked and piece measures 10½ (11½, 13, 14½)" [26.5 (29, 33, 37) cm] from beginning.

## Shape Neck and Shoulders

### First Shoulder

**Row 1:** Keeping in pattern st, work across first 22 (24, 26, 28) sts, leave remaining sts unworked.

**Row 2:** Work in pattern st across 22 (24, 26, 28) sts. Fasten off.

### Second Shoulder

**Row 1:** Skip next 21 (22, 23, 24) unworked sts on last full row worked, join yarn in next st with a slip st, ch 3, work in pattern to end of row.

**Row 2:** Work in pattern st across 22 (24, 26, 28) sts. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew Shoulders.

### Side Edging

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join yarn at side edge at lower edge of Back with a ch 1, sc evenly spaced along side edge from lower edge of Back to lower edge of Front.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Fasten off. Repeat along opposite side edge. Sew side seams 6 (7, 8, 9)" [15 (18, 20.5, 23) cm] from lower edge.

### Neck Edging

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join yarn at right shoulder seam ready to work across Back neck, sc 21 (22, 23, 24) sts evenly spaced across back neck, sc 6 sts along edges of rows of Front Neck, sc 21 (22, 23, 24) st across Front Neck, sc 6 along edges of Front Neck, slip st in first sc to join – 54 (56, 58, 60) sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in each sc around, slip st in top of beginning ch-3 – 54 (56, 58, 60) dc.

**Round 3:** Ch 2, turn, [Bpdc in next dc, Fpdc in next dc] around to last st, Bpdc in last dc, slip st in top of beginning ch-2. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

**Bpdc** = Back post double crochet; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **Fpdc** = Front post double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
