What you will need:

Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball each 422 Golden Yellow **A** and 401 Orchid Pink **B**

Note: Only small quantities of each color are needed for this project.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 2.75 mm [US C-2]

Yarn needle, stitch marker

GAUGE: Rounds 1-3 = 1" [2.5 cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



AUNT LYDIA'S®

Art. 154 available in white, ecru & natural 400 yd (366 m); solid color 350 yd (320 m); and shaded color 300 yd (274 m) balls

SHOP KIT

Cherry Blossom Appliqué

Add a pretty blossom to a denim jacket or anywhere you please. This easy crochet appliqué pattern can be crocheted in the color of your choice, or make a bouquet of them and give to all your friends! Blossoms can be sewn to any fabric or attached with fabric glue.

Rose measures 2½" [6.5 cm] diameter.

Note: Use double strand of Thread throughout.

Special Stitch

Join with sc: Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

ROSE

Beginning at center, with **A**, ch 2.

Round 1 (Right Side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (do not join)—6 sc. Place marker for beginning of Round and move marker up as each Round is completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Round 3: *Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—18 sc. Fasten off.

Round 4: With **B**, work in back loops only for this Round. Join with a sc in back loop of first sc of Round 3 (see Special Stitch), sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—24 sc.

Round 5: *Ch 3, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first loop—12 ch-3 loops.

Round 6: Ch 1, [sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc] in each ch-3 loop around; join with slip st in first sc—12 petals. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Round 7: Join **B** with a sc in any unworked front loop of Round 3; [ch 1, 2 dc in next front loop, ch 1, sc in next front loop] 7 times, ch 1, 2 dc in last front loop, ch 1; join with slip st in first sc—9 petals. Fasten off, leaving end for sewing.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc.;
ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
