What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball each 4601 Off White, 9274 Biscuit, 9440 Light Grey Heather

Tape



RED HEART® Soft®, Art E728 available in solid 5 oz (141 g), 256 yds (234 m); multits 4 oz (113 g), 204 yrd (187 m); heathers 4 oz (113 g), 212 yrd (194 m) balls



Woven Wire Basket

A purchased wire basket becomes a decorator accessory by embellishing with yarn. Our basket has a woven top border done with yarn left over from other projects. We encourage you to use your imagination and create your own unique basket.

Basket shown measures 9" (3cm) x 15" (38cm); instructions may be adapted to any wire basket.

Note

Measure around basket and multiply by one-and-a-half times. For basket shown, 48" (1.2m) circumference x 1.5 times = 72" or 2 yds (1.8m)

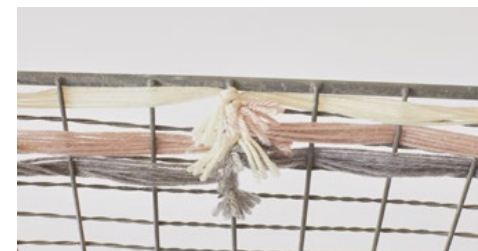
BASKET

1. Decide how many strands of yarn will be enough to fill in spaces between wire rows. Sample has 7 to 9 strands of each color. Cut needed number of strands one-and-a-half times the circumference of basket.
2. Tape the ends of the yarn together. Knot the un-taped ends to a vertical wire at back of basket.



3. Weave over and under vertical wires.
4. At corners, it is good to go around outside of corner unless there is a bar to go under, wrap all the way around the corner wire.
5. Continue around until you meet the beginning knot; knot to same beginning vertical wire. Straighten any messy wraps, tighten knot, and cut extra yarn about an inch from both knots.

Repeat for each color of yarn.
